There were so many details that had to be left out of our story over this past year. #### The Bigger Issues An Overview

Here, I'm just going to highlight the left-out items that we believe are the most important to our story.

That included personal gain and luxuries, of which the Mahaut community saw none. - Deborah Augustine and the Minister of National Security, Raymond Blackmore, have (or had) a very close relationship, which enabled her to so thoroughly throw us under the bus.

The church in Dominica has chosen to believe they are not to play any part in the nation's governing. Therefore, they do not admonish the government for even the most basic of sins.
The judgment of sexual perversion has taken root and is now clearly visible. This was something Jason warned of shortly after we arrived on island. Pastors, laymen, and people on the street all told him the "woke agenda" wouldn't come to Dominica.

We also found out, through a call to Mr. Blackmore's secretary, that Jason will NOT be allowed to enter Dominica when he arrives on the 3<sup>rd</sup>. How this can be, since he has a matter before the court that he was ordered to be at by the Magistrate, is beyond me.
