- Can be conducted in multiple sessions for the entire school population or facilitated to a select number of students identified by the school
- 1 hour long assemblies that address social emotional learning with a focus on self-esteem, self-worth, and making positive choices
- Group Participation Activities, Question-Answer Interactions, and Engaging Content that support the overall pillars of *Live R.I.C.H.*

Our assemblies stress the importance of living with **R**espect, Integrity, **C**onfidence, and **H**umility. Students are drawn into the content of the programming through captivating interaction, relatable dialogue, and fun. Students are engaged through real life scenarios in which consequences are discussed as well as positive solutions to help avoid pitfalls in the future. Students are encouraged to fulfill their dreams by utilizing a growth mindset, creating goals for themselves, and building positive relationships.

Students will leave the assembly with an understanding of what it means to: Have **RESPECT** for myself and others, realizing my actions affect more than just me Have **INTEGRITY** by taking responsibility for my actions and doing the right thing Have **CONFIDENCE** in myself and all of my abilities, I have to believe in me first Have **HUMILITY** by being strong enough to lead, but willing to learn
