Notes from the Pastor's Chair

I am writing from the refectory (the room for our common meals) at Wartburg Theological Seminary, where I spent my days after Easter. The tradition is that when you have been out for three years, you return for Reformation and Reunion. There are lectures for some of the time and lots of time to connect with classmates, now colleagues.

This is the first time I have been back on campus since graduating. It is my first time seeing the renovated Fritschel Hall (the main academic building). It marks the retirement of one of the professors who was instrumental to my journey. This professor was also on my candidacy committee and was one of the first faces I knew arriving on campus.

As I said in a sermon during Lent, our class verse is Isaiah 43:19, "I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth; do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." This verse has been popping up a lot for me lately, including at this event. I take this as a sign to study deeper and listen to what God is trying to say to me.

This is the middle of my third year of service at Calvary and St. Paul, and that amazes me. I wonder where the time has gone. In talking to my colleagues and sharing stories, we all agreed that your third year is another milestone.

The first year of your call is like drinking from a fire hose because the learning curve is steep and fast. This makes your second year feel like you can finally take a deep breath. This year has been a new phase. I don't know how to describe it. We are all still learning about each other-



which is a journey. It's a journey that we undertake together with God. Jesus took many journeys in his three years of ministry, and the

lesson that I learned from those is that sometimes our journeys are short, and others take a long time, and the results are not always obvious.

I am reminded of the words from Isaiah, "I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." God is always doing a new thing in all of our lives. Sometimes, the 'new thing" is joyful and exciting, and sometimes, the "new thing" is scary and daunting. But reassurance and hope come from our faith in a God that is always present with us. Belief in a God who loves us and whose only want is to be in a relationship with us and in a God that was crucified, buried, and rose again-beating death.

That belief can be hard to keep at the forefront of our minds. It can be too easily pushed to the back by fear, distrust, wariness, old hurts, and other things that we experience as people in the world. Like keeping up with colleagues and friends that are flung far and wide in the world, we must work at it consistently. We do that by reading scripture, praying, and partaking of the wine and bread.

I won't know how I will describe this third year of ministry for a while, but I know that God is at work in it. I know that God is constantly doing a new thing. Let's keep doing new things together.

WOMEN OF WORSHIP (WOW) AT ST. PAUL Wednesday, May 7 at 11am


WOW meets monthly at St. Paul for planning of events & fellowship. All women from Calvary & St. Paul are welcome to attend.
