



# Notes from the Pastor's Chair

Travel broadens your horizons. In October, we traveled to Paris for a vacation. We had never been there. We visited many of the must-sees, such as the Louvre, the Eiffel Tower, Versailles, and Disneyland Paris. I have a bachelor's degree in history emphasizing European History and couldn't wait to see Versailles. I can still remember the lectures and discussions of France during the time of Louis XIV. Versailles didn't disappoint. The physical place gave me grounding for all the knowledge I had in my head. It was an amazing experience.

When the opportunity to travel to Greece and Turkey and follow in Paul's footsteps came up early this year, I couldn't pass it up. I never pictured myself traveling abroad twice in less than six months, but here we are.

This trip is sponsored by Wartburg Seminary and is part of their Cross-Cultural requirement for graduation. (I went to Germany in 2022 and visited the Luther sites. I'll write about that sometime later.) They open these international trips to their alumni.

So, this January, Kristin and I will join my New Testament professor, the academic dean, six other spouses, twelve Wartburg alumni, and twenty current students for a twelve-day journey in Greece and Turkey that roughly follows Paul's second mission in Acts.

We will visit Phillipi, where Paul preached his first sermon in Europe and baptized the first Christian converts on European soil. We will see Thessaloniki, where Paul founded a church that would receive two letters and visit Corinth, which had such a significant Christian presence that Paul wrote two letters to them.

Hopping over to Turkey, we will visit Ephesus, where Paul spent time preaching and where Mary, mother of Jesus is believed to have lived. We will also visit monasteries, Mosques, archaeological sites, and museums. Guides will give daily devotions and presentations throughout the journey.

In preparation for this trip, I have been asked to read several essays and refresh my knowledge of the Book of Acts. The professor who is leading this group was my New Testament professor, and his teaching sparked my interest in the book of Acts and Paul. The passion and love that he has for this topic is infectious. When the opportunity to travel with Professor Troftgruben to experience these sites' history and biblical significance offered itself, it was an easy decision. The chance to combine learning about the roots of our civilization and our faith simultaneously was too good to pass up.

I am hoping that being in the places where Paul preached, baptized, and evangelized will deepen my faith in the words Paul wrote to the Thessalonians and Corinthians. Putting concrete places and contexts to the letters will give them a richer and fuller meaning. I can then bring that back to my preaching and teaching in the congregation. I plan to present my trip at an adult forum if interested.

There will be no Days for Girls in January of 2025. Meeting/Workdays will resume in February.


#### WOMEN OF WORSHIP (WOW) AT ST. PAUL Wednesday, January 5 at 11am
