



HOMETOWN HERO BANNER PROGRAM

Mount Penn Borough is proud to honor our servicemen and women by facilitating the Mount Penn Hometown Heroes Program. This program is a community memorial to those who have served our communities and country. Banners may be posted for United States Military veterans or Uniformed First Responders. While the program was created to honor local men and women, any application will be considered regardless of where an applicant has been born or raised but should have a nexus to the Borough of Mount Penn. The Hometown Heroes Banners are paid for by sponsors who may be friends, family, or businesses. Sponsors will be named on the banners.

All costs need to be paid before ordering the banner. The applicants must cover the total cost for the banners, which currently cost \$234.45 as of December 31st, 2024. The organization that prints these banners requires a minimum of five banners to be submitted at one time. The Borough will submit banners within these requirements, which may cause delays in the banners being posted.

Additional Details

- 1) The initial cost of a 24x48 banner is \$234.45. This cost covers the bracket kit, shipping, banner, and repairs if a banner or bracket parts are damaged or go missing.
- 2) If a replacement is necessary (such as due to weather events or vehicle accidents, etc.) the cost may increase slightly due to manufacturing costs. Checks must be made payable to Mount Penn Borough.
 - a. The banner's lifecycle is not guaranteed, but all retired banners will be returned to the sponsor.
- 3) You can attach a photo of your Hometown Hero to this form or bring it to the Mount Penn Borough building at 200 North 25th Street to be scanned. Any photos to be emailed should be sent to manager@mtpennborough.com.
- 4) Information about your hero will be printed and submitted with the form that is provided to you in this packet.
- 5) The Borough reserves the right to deny any application; all funds will be refunded.

THERE IS LIMITED POLE SPACE WITHIN THE BOROUGH TO DISPLAY THE HOMETOWN HERO BANNERS. IT IS A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS. THE BOROUGH CURRENTLY PLACES POSTERS ON PERKIOMEN AVENUE WITHIN MOUNT PENN.
