

# Mount Penn Borough Waste Collection Calendar

## CURBSIDE COLLECTION

Trash is collected two times (2) per week on Tuesday and Friday. Recycling material is collected one (1) time per week on Thursdays. Each residence may set out up to three (3) 35 gallon trash bags or containers each trash collection day. Containers cannot exceed thirty-five (35) gallons and may not weigh more than forty (40) pounds.

## SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING COLLECTION

**Mt. Penn Borough uses "single-stream" recycling program which makes it easier than ever to recycle.** Your household recycling will all go in the same container. **No need to separate your papers, metals, cardboard, glass and plastics, etc.**

## WHAT CAN BE PLACED OUT AS RECYCLABLES?

Paper and Cardboard (**no books, no contaminated pizza boxes**) Wax Cartons: Milk, juice, soup, flavored drinks and cartons can be recycled, Aluminum, Glass (**no window glass, mirrors, light bulbs**), Plastics #1- #7 (**no toys, styrofoam, ceramics**)

## BULK ITEM COLLECTION

Bulk Items will be collected on the first (1st) Friday of each month, the same day as trash. Each residence is permitted to set out for collection one (1) bulk item.

## ACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS:

- Furniture
- Carpet rolled and tied maximum length 48"
- Construction & Demolition debris cut to maximum length of 48"
- Washers, Dryers, Dishwashers
- Other household items too large for regular weekly collection

## BULK ITEM MATTRESS AND BOX SPRING DISPOSAL

Mattresses and box springs must be bagged and sealed in plastic mattress bags when placed curbside. Items may be set out on your regularly scheduled trash/bulk service day. These plastic bags are available at Amazon®, Home Depot® and Lowes®.

## UNACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS INCLUDE BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING LIST:

Appliances that contain Freon  
(for example: refrigerators or air conditioners)

- Liquids
- Paints and stains
- Chemicals
- Household hazardous wastes
- Tires on or off rims
- Construction and Demolition Waste larger than 48"
- Electronics and covered devices \*see notice.

## HOLIDAY COLLECTION

If a holiday falls on a or before a collection day, collection will occur the next day (see calendar).

**Holidays:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
