Mr. Theodossiou,

On February 14, 2025, the Mount Penn Borough Council's Merger Ad-Hoc Committee met in a public session at Borough Hall. Borough Council further discussed it at the February 18, 2025, meeting. Our partner entities also received prior communication so that they could be aware of that meeting's outcome. This copy will also be shared with them.

The merger discussions focused on baseline areas including the form of government, the governing body, and potential names. Several members of the community were present for these meetings. An agenda from both meetings is attached to this letter for reference, and the recommendations of Borough Council are included below:

- 1. Form of Government: 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Township
- 2. Representation Type of the Governing Body: At-Large Districts
- 3. Total Membership of the Governing Body: 5 Members
- 4. Potential Names: Mt. Penn, Lower Alsace, Antietam Valley, and Penn-Alsace.
- 5. Form of Financial Review: The committee recommends discussing whether staff can provide an adequate financial review of a potential merged municipality.

Borough Council unanimously agreed that a five-member governing body would provide a better balance of community representation than a three-member board while providing more focused decision-making than a seven-member board. They emphasized the importance of honoring the Borough's unique identity and suggested that designating Mt. Penn as a village or a similar designation could achieve this. A name reflecting the merged entity's past and future was also deemed ideal.

Borough Council supported, sharing these with Lower Alsace Township for discussion. Additionally, they agreed with adopting a resolution to clearly state that selling the community's water or sewer assets is financially irresponsible and wrong, sending a strong message that such sales would be a mistake, regardless of the outcome of a merger.
