

ORDINANCE NO. 693

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MT. PENN, BERKS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 653,
CHAPTER 21, PART 2, §204, §§2
SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mt. Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 21, Part 2, Section 204, Subsection 2, of the Ordinance No. 653 of the Borough of Mt. Penn, shall be amended to read as follows:

2. It shall be unlawful for any person, association, partnership or corporation to throw, cast or deposit or cause to be thrown, cast or deposited any snow, ice, hail or sleet into or onto any streets or public highways or fire hydrants situate within the Borough of Mount Penn.

ARTICLE II. REPEALER. Any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith.

ARTICLE III. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective after due advertisement in accordance with the law.
