

ORDINANCE NO. 694

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE
TEMPORARY CLOSING OF 24TH STREET, BETWEEN
PERKIOMEN AVENUE AND WOODVALE AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby directed and authorized that 24th Street, between Perkiomen Avenue and Woodvale Avenue, in the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, be temporarily closed to public use from 5:00 P.M. to 11:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 15, 2000, Friday, June 16, 2000 and Saturday, June 17, 2000.

SECTION 2. Be it further provided that the closing of said street, by the Borough of Mount Penn, to public use shall be without liability upon the part of the Borough of Mount Penn.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
