ordinance no. 698

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 653 REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF MINORS ON STREETS AT NIGHT

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

ARTICLE I. Section 103 A of Chapter 6, Part 1 of Ordinance No. 653, of the Borough of Mount Penn, shall be amended, as follows:

A. It shall be unlawful for any minor to be or remain in or upon any public highway, park or other public place within the Borough of Mount Penn or in any enclosure or vehicle which is on or in close proximity to any such public place within the Borough, between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. on the following day official prevailing time, unless accompanied by the person charged with control after an event or activity which ended between the limiting hours; or, unless such minor is in lawful employment making it necessary to be in such place between the said hours; or, unless there exists a reasonable necessity therefor. The fact that a minor, unaccompanied as aforesaid, is found in any of the aforesaid places within the Borough during said time period shall be prima facie evidence that said minor is there unlawfully and that no reasonable necessity or compelling reason exists therefore.

ARTICLE II. REPEALER. Any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith.

ARTICLE III. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective after due advertisement in accordance with the law.
