## ORDINANCE NO. 704

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 687, PART 4, RESTRICTING PARKING FOR HANDICAPPED USE ONLY BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST INTERSECTION OF HOLLYWOOD AVENUE AND HOLLYWOOD COURT ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF HOLLYWOOD COURT AT A POINT 130 FEET EAST OF THE INTERSECTION OF HOLLYWOOD AVENUE AND HOLLYWOOD COURT AND CONTINUING FOR A DISTANCE OF 24 FEET EAST ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF HOLLYWOOD COURT

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Parking shall be restricted for handicapped use only beginning at the northeast intersection of Hollywood Avenue and Hollywood Court along the North side of Hollywood Court at a point 130 feet east of the intersection of Hollywood Avenue and Hollywood Court and continuing for a distance of 24 feet east along the north side of Hollywood Court.

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
