

**ORDINANCE NO. 705**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 653, CHAPTER 15, PART 3, RESTRICTING TRUCK TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN STREETS**

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.** Section 302 of Chapter 15, Part 3 of Ordinance No. 653, of the Borough of Mount Penn, shall be amended by adding the following:

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a tri-axle vehicle, or larger, on the following streets or parts of streets in the Borough of Mount Penn:

<b>STREET</b>	<b>BETWEEN</b>	<b>RESTRICTION</b>
Oak Terrace	Entire Length	Any Direction

**ARTICLE II. REPEALER.** Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and same are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith.

**ARTICLE III. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall become effective after due advertisement in accordance with the law.


