ORDINANCE NO. 705

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 653, CHAPTER 15, PART 3, RESTRICTING TRUCK TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN STREETS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

ARTICLE I. Section 302 of Chapter 15, Part 3 of Ordinance No. 653, of the Borough of Mount Penn, shall be amended by adding the following:

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a tri-axle vehicle, or larger, on the following streets or parts of streets in the Borough of Mount Penn:

STREET

BETWEEN

RESTRICTION

Oak Terrace

Entire Length

Any Direction

ARTICLE II. REPEALER. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and same are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith.

ARTICLE III. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective after due advertisement in accordance with the law.
