ORDINANCE NO. 706

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 687, PART 4, RESCINDING CERTAIN HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES LOCATED WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF MT. PENN.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The following handicapped parking spaces are hereby rescinded and it shall be hereinafter lawful for any person or persons to park a duly licensed and registered vehicle in the following locations:

- A. 2545 Cumberland Avenue - starting a distance of 125' west of the Endlich Avenue curb line and running a distance of 20' west along the north side of Cumberland Avenue;
- B. 1927 Fairview Avenue - in front of 1927;
- C. 1975 Woodvale Avenue - starting a distance of 152' west of South 20th Street curb line and running a distance of 20' west to the post bearing the sign, along the north side of Woodvale Avenue; and
- D. 2438 Cumberland Avenue - beginning 230 feet west of North 25th Street to post bearing "Handicapped" sign, located 660 feet east of Beech Street, and continuing 22 feet west

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
