ORDINANCE NO. 710

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 673,
SECTION I, PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS, CATS OR OTHER PETS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

ARTICLE I. Section 1 of the Ordinance No. 673 of the Borough of Mount Penn, shall be amended as follows: It shall be hereafter unlawful for any person or persons to permit any dog, cat or other pet, owned by or under the custody, supervision or control of such person or persons, to be unleashed while off the property of the owner or person in control or supervision of said pet, and/or permit said pet to run at large either upon the public streets, alleys or sidewalks in the Borough or upon property of another, including the property of the Borough of Mount Penn or of any school district.

ARTICLE II. REPEALER Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective after due advertisement in accordance with the law.
