ORDINANCE NO. 716

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN,  
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 687,  
PART 6- §601(1) RIDING AND PARKING OF PEDACYCLES ON SIDEWALKS  
ALONG CERTAIN STREETS PROHIBITED.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn,  
Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority  
of the same, as follows:

ARTICLE I. Part 6, Section 601, Subsection 1, of Ordinance No. 687 of  
the Borough of Mount Penn, shall be amended as follows: It shall be unlawful for  
any person, excepting out police officers, to ride or to park a pedalcycle in  
the Borough of Mount Penn where it would interfere with or create a hazard to  
pedestrian traffic.

ARTICLE II. REPEALER Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances  
inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
