ORDINANCE NO. 741

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 653,
CHAPTER 25, SECTION 105, OBSTRUCTION; TREES TO BE PRUNED**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by authority of the same, as follows:

ARTICLE I. Section 105 of Chapter 25 of Ordinance No. 653 of the Borough of Mount Penn, shall be amended as follows: It shall be the duty of any person or persons owning or occupying real property bordering on any street upon which property there may be trees, to prune such trees in such manner that they will not obstruct or shade the street lights, obstruct the passage of pedestrians on sidewalks, obstruct vision of traffic signs, or obstruct view of any street or alley intersection. The minimum clearance of any overhanging portion thereof shall be ten (10) feet over sidewalks and thirteen feet (13') over all streets.

ARTICLE II. REPEALER Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed. All other sections of this Ordinance shall remain the same.

ARTICLE III. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective after due advertisement in accordance with the law.
