**ORDINANCE NO. 747**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 687, CHAPTER 15, §404, PROVIDING FOR HANDICAPPED PARKING AND REMOVING RESTRICTED PARKING ZONES .**

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1.       §404 shall be amended to include:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>	<u>RESTRICTION</u>
1968 Woodvale	South	232 feet west of the Intersection of S. 20 <sup>th</sup> St. and Woodvale Avenue and continuing in a westerly direction for a distance of 22 feet.	Handicapped use only

SECTION 2.       §404 shall be amended by removing the following restrictions:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>	<u>RESTRICTION</u>
Cumberland Avenue	North	84' east of Center Street and continuing for a distance of 22' in an easterly direction	Handicapped placarded
Fairview Avenue	South	58' east of the curbline on the southeast corner of South 23 <sup>rd</sup> Street and Fairview Avenue and Continuing 22 feet west	Handicapped use only

Fairview Avenue	North	416' west of the curblin on the northwest corner of South 20 <sup>th</sup> Street and Continuing 22' west to a Sign post bearing the Reserved parking/fines signs	Handicapped use only
Grant Street	South	270' from the southeast curblin of the intersection of North 25 <sup>th</sup> Street and Grant Street, and continuing east on the south side of Grant Street for a distance of 22'	Handicapped use only
Hollywood Court	North	130' east of the intersection with Hollywood Avenue continuing for a distance of 24' east	Handicapped use only
South 23 <sup>rd</sup> Street	East	50' feet north of Fairview and continuing for a Distance of 22' in a Northerly direction	Handicapped placarded

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
