**ORDINANCE NO. 756**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 687, PART 4, ADDING RESERVED PARKING FOR 2410 FILBERT AVENUE AND 2517 CUMBERLAND AVENUE AND RESCINDING 15 MINUTE PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF PERKIOMEN AVENUE AND HANDICAPPED PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF SOUTH 22<sup>ND</sup> STREET.**

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Adding restricted parking for handicapped use only for 2410 Filbert Avenue, beginning at the intersection of N. 24<sup>th</sup> Street and Filbert Avenue at the southeast curb line and continuing east on the south side of Filbert Avenue for 124 feet to the sign post.

SECTION 2. Adding restricted parking for handicapped use only for 2517 Cumberland Avenue, beginning at the intersection of Cumberland Avenue and Center Street at the northwest curb line and continuing north on the west side of Center Street for 74 feet to a sign post.

SECTION 3. Rescinding restricted parking for business use only, Monday through Friday, for fifteen minutes between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on the south side of Perkiomen Avenue beginning 102 feet east of the intersection of South 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Perkiomen Avenue and continuing 22 feet east along the south side of Perkiomen Avenue.

SECTION 4. Rescinding restricted parking for handicapped use only, on the west side of South 22<sup>nd</sup> Street beginning 98 feet north of the intersection of Fairview Street and South 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and continuing 20 feet north.

SECTION 5. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
