ORDINANCE NO. 761

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 653, CHAPTER 15,
SECTION 203 ADDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A ONE-WAY STREET
DURING SPECIFIED DAYS AND PERIODS OF TIME AND PROVIDING FOR
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. North 25th Street is established as a one-way street from 8:25 a.m. to 8:55 a.m. and from 2:55 p.m. to 3:25 p.m. Monday through Friday in each week, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on said street other than in the direction established for traffic on that street, as follows:

SECTION 2. Appropriate signage shall be erected (or ratified if previously erected).

SECTION 3. Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and costs.

SECTION 4. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
