**ORDINANCE NO. 768**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008.**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real property within said Borough, subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 2007 at 7.4 mills as follows:


Tax rate for the general purposes and street lighting, the sum of 6.4 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Tax rate for fire/emergency purposes the sum of 1.0 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**SECTION 2.** That any Ordinance or part of Ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same effects this Ordinance.
