ORDINANCE NO. 783

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 653,
CHAPTER 20, SOLID WASTE**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by authority of the same, as follows:

ARTICLE I. Section 104-1B of Chapter 20 of Ordinance No. 653 of the Borough of Mount Penn shall be amended to read:
Glass and plastics.

ARTICLE II. Section 104-2D of Chapter 20 of Ordinance No. 653 of the Borough of Mount Penn shall be amended to read:
Glass and plastics.

ARTICLE III. Section 203 of Chapter 20 of Ordinance No. 653 of the Borough of Mount Penn shall be amended to read:

The Borough imposes a refuse collection charge (which includes the charge for recyclable collection) for the calendar year on each habitable property at the rate of \$215 per dwelling unit, commercial or industrial establishment at which the refuse and/or recyclable collection service is provided by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn. The fee will be prorated and invoiced for any dwellings that are converted from single family to multi-family dwellings or apartments during the calendar year.

ARTICLE IV. Section 211-5A – D of Chapter 20 of Ordinance No. 653 of the Borough of Mount Penn shall be amended to read:

A. There will be a limit of three 35 gallon bags or containers per residential unit and/or industrial property for refuse.

B. Each container, when filled, shall weigh no more than one man can normally lift onto the collection truck (fifty-pound limit).

C. Containers and/or plastic bags will be accepted as approved containers.

ARTICLE V. Section 211-6A of Chapter 20 of Ordinance No. 653 of the Borough of Mount Penn shall be amended to read:

A. Refuse pick-up is to be Tuesday and Friday. Recyclable pick-up to be on each Tuesday.

ARTICLE VI. REPEALER Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed. All other sections of this Ordinance shall remain the same.

ARTICLE VII. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective after due advertisement in accordance with the law.
