ORDINANCE NO. 793

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 687, PART 4, RESTRICTING PARKING FOR HANDICAPPED USE ONLY ON THE NORTH SIDE OF FAIRVIEW AVENUE, COMMENCING 204 FEET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH 20TH STREET AND CONTINUING WESTERLY FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET, AND RESCINDING ORDINANCE #770 AND #780, ELIMINATING TWO (2) HANDICAPPED PARKING ONLY LOCATIONS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Mount Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Parking shall be restricted for handicapped use only on the North side of Fairview Avenue, commencing 204 feet from the intersection of South 20th Street and continuing Westerly for a distance of 22 feet.

SECTION 2. This section hereby rescinds Ordinance #770, thereby eliminating restricted parking for handicapped use only, on the East side of Brighton Avenue, commencing 47 feet North of the intersection of Hollywood Court and continuing in a Northerly direction for a distance of 22 feet.

SECTION 3. This section hereby rescinds Ordinance #780, thereby eliminating handicapped parking on Filbert Avenue beginning at a point sixty-three (63) feet East of the intersection of Filbert and 24th Street, on the South side a distance of twenty-two (22) feet adjacent to 2402 Filbert Avenue.

SECTION 4. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
