A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER ALSACE, BERKS COUNTY, IN COOPERATION WITH THE MEMBERS OF BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT PENN, BERKS COUNTY, TO INITIATE A JOINT PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS A POSSIBLE MERGER

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Alsace and Members of the Borough Council of Mount Penn Borough recognize the struggles incurred daily within small municipalities and the need to cooperate and,

WHEREAS, during the past few years both the Township of Lower Alsace and the Borough of Mount Penn have entertained the idea of a possible merger to aid in a more beneficial delivery of public service and,

WHEREAS, both elected officials recognize the importance of public input and education.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors from Lower Alsace Township and the Members of the Borough Council of Mount Penn Borough wish to hold a public meeting to discuss a proposed merger; and,

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED, that Board of Supervisors from both Lower Alsace Township and the Members of Mount Penn Borough Council from Mount Penn Borough will host a joint public meeting on November 1, 2023, located at the Antietam School District Primary Center Auditorium, 201 North 25th Street, Reading, PA 19606, with additional meetings to be scheduled.
