- All the PA State laws governing Emergency Management are found in Title 35. It covers everything about the topic. If you trouble sleeping some night take a look. It can be found on line.
- Complete a letter stating who you are recommending for the position and signed by you as President of Council – must be on Mt Penn letterhead and is addressed to Donnie Swope, Planning Manager, Berks County Emergency Services, Direct Link Tech Center, 2561 Bernville Rd, Reading, PA 19605.

3. Complete the form and complete the background check (done by State Police) before mailing the papers to Donnie.

That should do it. After Donnie reviews the papers it gets passed up through channels. The official appointment comes from the Governor. As long as Donnie has your letter with the person's name he or she can start working, because he will have them listed for Mt Penn Borough.
