


## IRISH VODKA & POITÍN





## POITÍN IRISH MOONSHINE

Poitín, pronounced "put'cheen," is unaged white whiskey that has been made in Irish villages for decades. It is essentially what Americans call "moonshine." Historically, rural distillers operating in western Ireland's isolated townlands relied on a keen eye for the exciseman and their neighbors' generosity to help pay the hefty fine if they were caught distilling their own poitín. One of our founders had a great-great uncle, John Mullarkey, who spent a few months in the local jail, Silgo Gaol, for the crime of illicit distillation. Whereas John Mullarkey used a small, portable still hidden in Ireland's Ox Mountains, we use Connacht Distillery's beautiful copper stills and a traditional malted barley base for the mash. Although poitín is oftentimes very high proof – as much as 120 – ours has a more restrained proof point of 90 (45% ABV).

## IRISH VODKA

Because Americans often equate potatoes with Ireland, using them to make Irish vodka makes sense, at least at first blush. However, Connacht Distillery is located in western Ireland where potato farming is not particularly prevalent, so we opted to use wheat as the base of our vodka. It is batch distilled in copper pot stills and hand bottled at our distillery at 80 proof (40% ABV). Straw Boys Irish Vodka has a rich mouthfeel that is luscious, silky, and semi-sweet. Like the traditional wedding crashing straw boys of western Ireland, our vodka is fun and spirited.
