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AVOID THE ENTANGLEMENT

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YAHUSHA has made us free from sin, which is the curse of The Law, so that we can not be entangled in that bondage again. Not only did YAHUSHA free us from hard physical bondage in Egypt but also spiritual bondage. The Truth, which is The Law, shall set us free from both realms of bondage. But if we can't see or admit that we are in a state of bondage physically and spiritually, then we can't see how we are servants of sin.

JOHN 8:32-36 (KJV) 32 AND YE SHALL KNOW THE TRUTH, AND THE TRUTH SHALL MAKE YOU FREE. 33 THEY ANSWERED HIM, WE BE ABRAHAM'S SEED, AND WERE NEVER IN BONDAGE TO ANY MAN: HOW SAYEST THOU, YE SHALL BE MADE FREE? 34 YAHUSHA ANSWERED THEM, VERILY, VERILY, I SAY UNTO YOU, WHOSOEVER COMMITTETH SIN IS THE SERVANT OF SIN. 35 AND THE SERVANT ABIDETH NOT IN THE HOUSE FOR EVER: [BUT] THE SON ABIDETH EVER. 36 IF THE SON THEREFORE SHALL MAKE YOU FREE, YE SHALL BE FREE INDEED.

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The Passover

**Exodus 12:42-42
(KJV)**

It [is] a night to be much observed unto YAHUAH for bringing them out from the land of Egypt: this [is] that night of YAHUAH to be observed of all the children of Israel in their generations.

Passover is a Feast Day set by YAHUAH to be done in remembrance of YAHUAH freeing our ancestors from Egyptian captivity. During the first Passover we can see YAHUSHA's compassion to the Children Of Israel. While being under slavery, aka hard bondage, He heard the cries of the children of Israel and had compassion. Placing plagues on the Egyptians whenever Pharaoh refused to let His people go. His compassion is so grand that after freeing us He did not leave us just to be the Children of Israel but made us the Nation of Israel as promised to our forefathers.

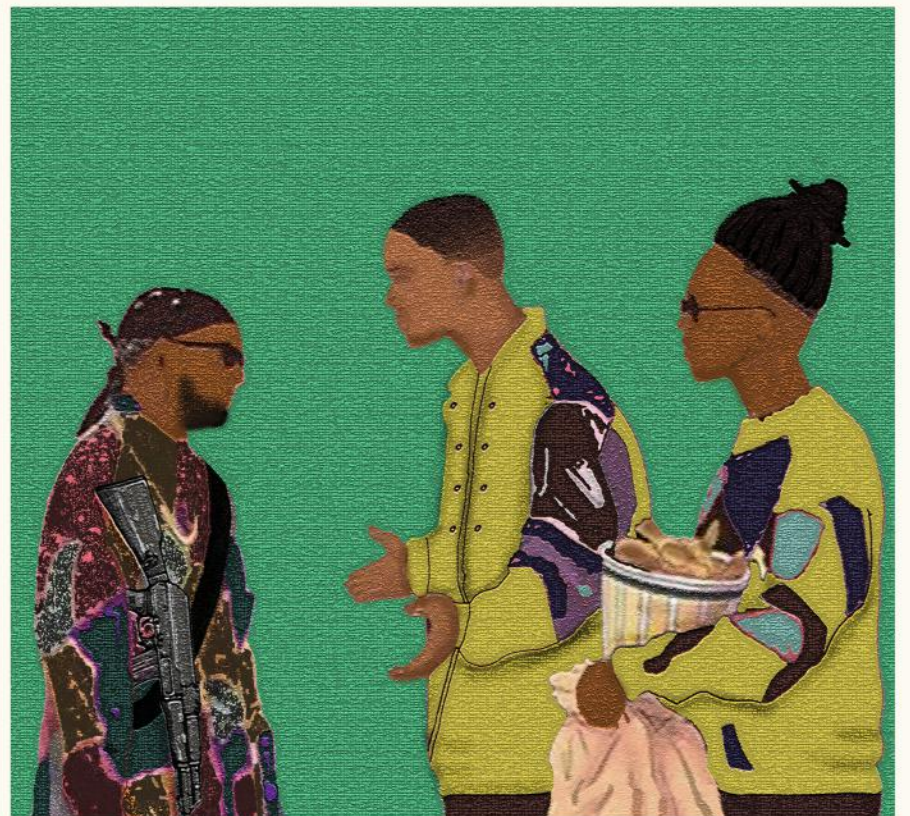




Kinsman Redeemer

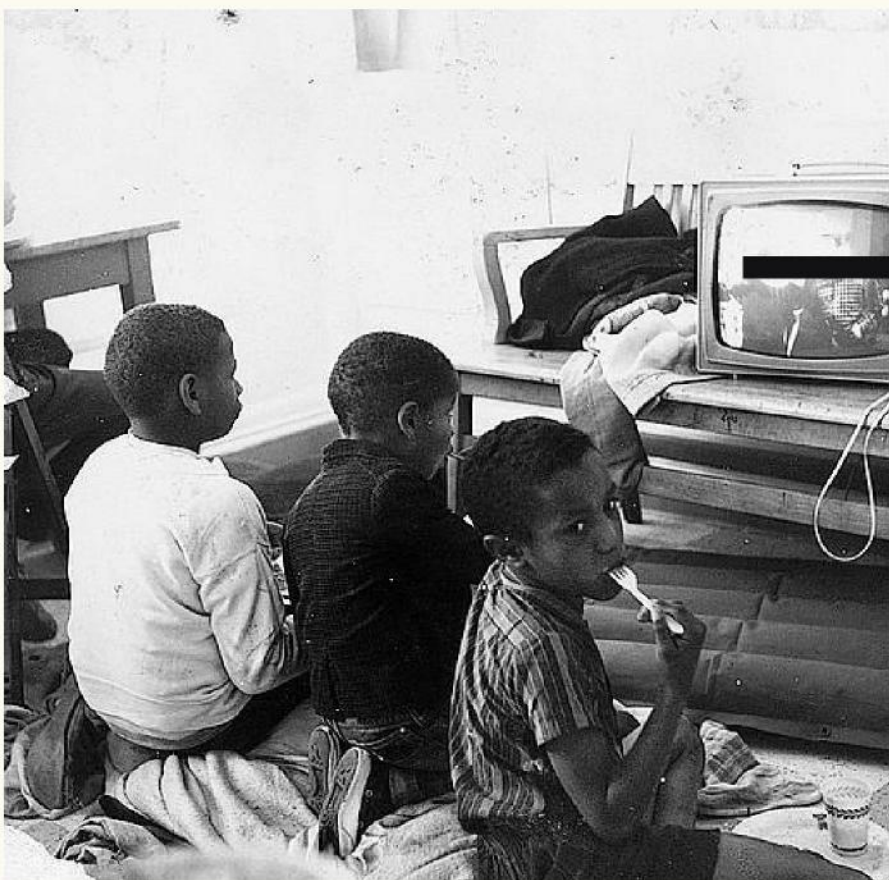
