










GOOD WORKS


We no longer have anymore animals to bring as a form of sacrificial works, but YAHUSHA did mention a new form of works. These works include feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, housing strangers, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and those in prison.

These are considered good works in The Kingdom. But these good works must be done according to faith to be completely good in The Eyes of YAHUAH. Even YAHUSHA made mention of this.

Think about this. How can these many wonderful works be done towards The Master YAHUSHA and He responds I never knew you: depart from Me you workers of iniquity? Because these works have to be works of faith. Just as faith without good works are dead, good works without faith is dead.

Iniquity by definition is sinning knowingly. For us to call YAHUSHA our Master, then we should have knowledge of what He labels as sin. 



Sin by definition says it is an immoral act considered to be a transgression against Divine Law.


The Law, The Ten Commandments, teaches us what is righteousness and what is sin in the Eyes of YAHUAH.
