### Tuesday, Sept. 2 Green Bay, WI

This morning, we leave southern Minnesota, cross the Mississippi River, and drive through the state of Wisconsin with a lunch stop along the way. Late this afternoon, we will be entering the Green Bay area to visit the newly renovated Green Bay Packers Hall of Fame Museum. Our home for the next two evenings will be at the **Radisson Hotel**

### Wednesday, Sept. 3 Green Bay, WI

After breakfast, we will begin a full-day tour of Door County, including the Maritime Museum and Door Peninsula Winery. You may view the beautiful marina and shoreline or browse the “Butik” before enjoying an included authentic Scandinavian luncheon experience while dining at Al Johnson’s Swedish Restaurant in Sister Bay, where the goats may be grazing on the restaurant’s sod rooftop, waiting for the perfect photo opportunity. ### Friday, Sept. 5 Marinette, WI

After breakfast, a horse-drawn carriage will be awaiting you for a tour of the island. We’ll have time to enjoy spectacular views of the Straits of Mackinac and the beautiful gardens while standing on the world’s longest porch of the Grand Hotel. We’ll be guests for an included lunch buffet at the Grand Hotel, which has welcomed visitors since 1887. We will depart the island by ferry taking us to Mackinaw City, and board the motorcoach. Have your cameras ready as once again we’ll cross the Mackinac Bridge and begin our scenic afternoon drive to Marinette, WI for the night.
