

## Tuesday, June 18

This morning we'll step aboard our deluxe motor coach, depart Minnesota, and "stitch" our way to a quilting paradise! After lunch, our first stop of the day is **Mill House Quilts, Waunakee, WI**. Walking into Mill House Quilts reminds you of a brilliant autumn afternoon. Vibrant splashes of color, massive beams of the old mill arch and the plank floor, just like 100 years ago, entice you to visit this quaint shop. Our evening accommodations are at the **Fairfield Inn & Suites** in Hammond, IL.

## Wednesday, June 19

There's always something exciting happening at Shipshewana; and today you will realize why the locals hold their heritage close to their hearts, and visitors admire a life of simplicity. Begin your Shipshewana experience at the Menno-Hof Interpretive Center while seeing and hearing the Amish-Mennonite story through presentations, historical environments, and displays. Lunch is on your own at the Shipshewana Trading Place Flea Market & Auction where over 900 vendors offer bargains galore! This afternoon the **2019 Quilt & Vendor Show** at the Shipshewana Event Center opens their doors, and you can look forward to the "best of the best" when vendors from around the country will provide you with their products. You will not be disappointed! The day will be complete with a **Quilting Bee & Dining at The Carriage House** where local Amish women invite you to a delicious meal and joining in hand quilting or just simply watching. After building memories, our accommodations for the next two nights are at the **Farmstead Inn**.



## Thursday, June 20

This morning we'll visit three quilt shops within walking distance from the hotel. **Yoder's Department Store** will go the extra mile in treating you like family while helping with selecting fabrics & calculating yardage. Once again we'll return to the **Quilt & Vendor Show**, located at the Shipshewana Event Center. Make your final purchases or just sit and listen to product presentations and demos. Enjoy lunch on your own at one of the concession stands within the facility. This afternoon inspiration is around every corner at **Lolly's Fabrics** where 1,000's of bolts will have you thinking, dreaming and planning your new creations. Your curiosity will be satisfied with a personal



and close-up look while taking time for shopping and enjoying a leisurely 30-minute buggy ride through Amish country and up-town Shipshewana. Dinner is on your own this evening; and you may want to experience great

home-style cooking and baked goods (anything your heart desires) at the **Blue Gate Restaurant & Bakery**. We'll return to the **Farmstead Inn** for rest and relaxation.

## Friday, June 21

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing Shipshewana and "skirting" around Chicago on our way to Monroe, Wisconsin. Smile – say "cheese" and feel a yodel coming on as we escape to America's Dairyland for a "farm fresh" drive through the rolling hills with picturesque farms dotting the horizon. Your appetite will be satisfied with an included Express Lunch Buffet at the Ratskeller Restaurant, located in the over 150 year-old Turner Hall. We'll take time to shop Monroe's downtown historic Courthouse Square; featuring a diversity of antique, specialty, clothing and gift shops. After lunch, a delightful visit to the **Alp and Dell Cheese Store** offers a short video presentation taking us through the cheese making and curing process and into the cellars. Perhaps Tony the Yodeler will

give a lesson on the art of yodeling! Later this afternoon we'll take a short drive to New Glarus – America's "**Little Switzerland**". You won't be disappointed when downtown shops entice you with apparel, accessories, antiques, Swiss imports, baked goods, fudge and home décor. Our overnight accommodations are at the **Chalet Landhaus Inn** in New Glarus where we'll be greeted with a Welcome Reception upon arrival. This evening a unique dining experience completes our day with an included Chef's cheese fondue demonstration and tasting, dinner with authentic Swiss cuisine and local Swiss entertainment!



## Saturday, June 22

A tour of **Barn Quilts** is on our agenda this morning when a step-on guide joins us with a wealth of information about the quilts, which are actually large painted quilt blocks on historic barns. The architecture of the barns, local agriculture, stories about the families and the farms where the quilts are located and fun facts about the Green County area will surely make you fall in love with their way of living. Bidding farewell to our neighboring state, we'll travel homeward to Minnesota, not forgetting about the small quaint towns in Northern Indiana Amish Country and the farming communities of Wisconsin, where friends gather and memories are made.
