A deposit of **\$200.00** per person is required to secure your reservation. Full payment is due **May 1, 2019**. Credit cards are not accepted.

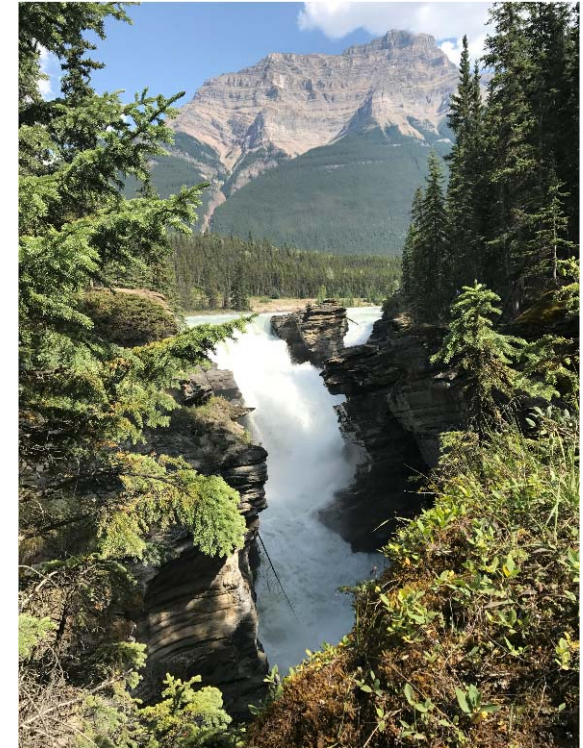

## **Wednesday, July 17**      **Minot, ND**

Our Canadian Rockies adventure begins by traveling with deluxe motor coach through central Minnesota to our included buffet lunch in Fargo. After lunch we will make our way to Minot for our overnight stay at the Grand Hotel.

## **Thursday, July 18**      **Whitefish, MT**

After breakfast our motor coach will provide transportation to the Amtrak station in Minot where we will travel by train in coach accommodations through western North Dakota into Montana. Later in the evening we will enjoy the sights of the southern part of Glacier National Park. Our evening stay will be at the Best Western in Whitefish.

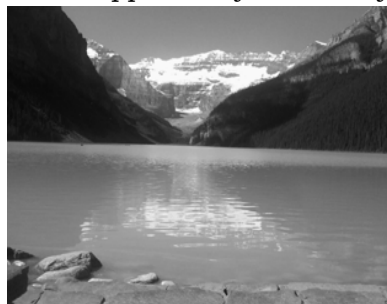
## **Friday, July 19**      **Fernie, BC**

This morning we'll travel to West Glacier to Lake McDonald where the historic red coaches are waiting for our guided tour of the "Going-to-the-Sun-Road". We will cross the Continental Divide at Logan Pass while enjoying the breathtaking view along this magnificent road, and have an included lunch before leaving the park. This afternoon our travels take us north into Canada for a cruise on the Upper Waterton Lake, where we will discover the "Jewel of the Rockies" at Waterton Glacier International Peace Park, the world's first of its kind. Winding through and crossing the Crows Nest Pass into British Columbia offers a scenic drive and we'll witness the Frank Slide Catastrophic Rockslide of 1903. Our overnight stay is at the Park Place Lodge in Fernie, British Columbia, Canada.



## **Saturday, July 20**      **Banff, AB**

After breakfast we can enjoy the beautiful valleys of B.C. Our first stop will be in Radium Hot Springs for our morning break. We will continue to travel to Golden, BC and have a relaxing included lunch at the Island Restaurant before entering Yoho National Park. The park is located along the western slopes of the Canadian Rockies. We will climb the Kicking Horse River Valley toward the continental divide into Alberta. This afternoon embrace the breathtaking scenery that Lake Louise offers and take advantage of the opportunity to walk by the lake while enjoying the view. Our home for the next two nights is at the Rundlestone Lodge in Banff. Nestled high in the Canadian Rockies, Banff is a town that makes you feel at home and exhilarated with wonder all at the same time.



## **Sunday, July 21**      **Banff, AB**

After breakfast our motor coach will wind through the Canadian Rockies, traveling on one of the most breathtaking scenic highways; and from there our group will board the Snocoach on the Athabasca Glacier where you will be standing on one of the largest accumulations of ice south of the Arctic Circle. Take time for lunch and shopping in the quaint little town of Jasper. After lunch we will view one of the beautiful water falls in the Jasper area, the Athabasca Falls; returning to our hotel that evening.

## **Monday, July 22**      **Calgary, AB**

This morning heighten your senses and experience the all-new Banff Gondola Summit. Journey to the top of Sulphur Mountain for the 360-degree rooftop observation deck, multi-sensory theater, and more. Before lunch we will have some additional time to explore downtown Banff. Our included lunch today will be at the luxurious Banff Springs Hotel, where you will be treated like royalty with the succulent food and beautiful ambience. This afternoon we will drive to the city of Calgary where a guide will show us the sights. Our hotel for the evening is the Country Inn & Suites of Calgary.

## **Tuesday, July 23**      **Moose Jaw, SK**

This morning our motorcoach takes us from Calgary, traveling through Alberta and Saskatchewan on Canadian Highway #1. Late this afternoon in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan, a short narrated trolley ride will explain the murals throughout the town and reveal the stories of the early 1900 gangsters. Our overnight stay will be at the Comfort Inn & Suites of Moose Jaw.
