Friday, July 2 Anchorage

This morning we will board our flight for a one-of-a-kind opportunity to the spectacular state of Alaska! Riley's Motor Coach will be awaiting our arrival upon reaching Anchorage. Our afternoon allows the opportunity of a true Alaskan experience while visiting the Native Heritage Museum, before going to our hotel for a two-night stay.

Saturday, July 3

Driving to Whittier after breakfast, we will stop at the Alyeska Ski Resort for the Aerial Tramway: a seven-minute ride taking you to an observation deck which provides breath-taking panoramic views of majestic mountains, hanging glaciers, sparkling streams, towering spruce, and an array of wildlife. Experience an unforgettable journey



while traveling in comfort aboard the Klondike Express into Prince William Sound on a 26 Glacier Cruise, with an informative narration by the US Forest Rangers. A hot lunch is provided while cruising.

Sunday, July 4 Denali

Learn a bit about Alaska's history while visiting the Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Museum, where a video lets us experience "The Last Great Race on Earth". View trophies, displays, photos, and for a fee take a thrilling trip down the trail with the dogs that make the Iditarod so unique. We will have lunch enroute. When traveling to Denali, we'll enjoy photo opportunities along the way, hoping to get a view of Denali formerly Mt. McKinley. A night of food, frivolity, and good cheer awaits as the cast takes you through an unforgettable, true-to-life Gold Rush tale of adventure in the early 1900 Alaska. The lighthearted mix of colorful storytelling, spirited music, and a hearty dinner complete with salmon, ribs, potatoes, old-fashioned baked beans, drop biscuits and berry cobbler will surely satisfy your appetite!

Monday, July 5 Denal

After breakfast we'll board a park bus for a Tundra Wilderness Tour of Denali National Park; keeping our eyes open for bear, moose, caribou, elk, birds and other small wildlife. While in Denali you may choose to do an optional activity such as a helicopter ride or river rafting.



Tuesday, July 6

A relaxing start of the day will begin with breakfast before making our way to Fairbanks. We will have an included lunch prior to joining the Binkley family as we board the Discovery Riverboat and cruise the Tanana and Chena Rivers. We'll explore the Eskimo cultures and see dog sled demonstrations as well as salmon fishing wheels. Tonight

we'll enjoy ourselves at the Salmon Bake feasting on all-you-can-eat salmon, cod, and prime rib. After dinner walk to Pioneer Park and enjoy "A True Alaska Experience"; a humorous musical depicting the "golden days" in Fairbanks.

Wednesday, July 7

Are you looking to strike gold? Experience Alaska's gold mining history at Gold Dredge 8. Enjoy a close up view of the Trans Alaska Pipeline and a presentation about its construction and operation. Take a seat aboard a replica of the narrow-gauge Tanana Valley Railroad and hear the conductor tell tales of prospectors who arrived by the thousands during the gold rush. The train takes you to Gold Dredge 8 where you will see first-hand how the dredge worked the gold fields; then receive a brief but informative course on gold panning. Once the train arrives at the camp, you will try panning for yourself! You will find gold - we guarantee it!! Just outside of Fairbanks we will stop in the town of North Pole for a chance to see the world famous Christmas House and the reindeer out back. Our home tonight will be in "The Crossroads of Alaska"— Tok.

Thursday, July 8 Whitehorse, Canada

This morning you will again be treated to breakfast and the remainder of the day will be spent traveling the Alaskan (ALCAN) Highway. Originally built in 1949, the highway has been greatly improved the past several years. Enjoy an included lunch in Destruction Bay; and a

rest stop at Big Horn Sheep Mountain will familiarize you with the wildlife of the area. This afternoon we will make a stop at the Kluane National Park and Reserve Visitor Centre. Tonight we'll stay at the Westmark of Whitehorse.

Friday, July 9 Juneau

The sternwheeler, SS Klondike, once a major transportation system, greets visitors to the city. A spectacular view is in store from the Miles Canyon Lookout on the Alaska Highway. Our hightlight of the day will be the White Pass/Yukon Railroad with an train excursion with photo opportunities around every turn. The train will arrive in Skagway, the town that owes its birth to the 1797 Gold Stampede, with their downtown historical district, false-fronted buildings, and boardwalk dating back to the Gold Rush! Later this afternoon we will board a private charter to cruise the Inside Passage. This narrow passage will define the route early settlers traveled, passing glaciers and icebergs en route to Juneau, Alaska's Capital City, for our two night stay at the Baranof Hotel.

Saturday, July 10 Juneau

Today is at your leisure. You may choose to relax at the hotel, shop, take a short jaunt to the Red Dog Saloon, ride up the Mount Roberts Tramway, tour the newly opened Alaska State Museum or truly have an Alaskan Experience by Salmon and Halibut fishing or Whale Watching that would be arranged prior to arrival.

Sunday, July 11 Home

After breakfast before we bid farewell to Alaska we will tour Juneau's biggest attraction, Mendenhall Glacier & the Macaulay Salmon Hatchery. After lunch our grand vacation to Alaska comes to a close as we board our flight home; taking with us an adventure packed with memories of "The Last Frontier".
