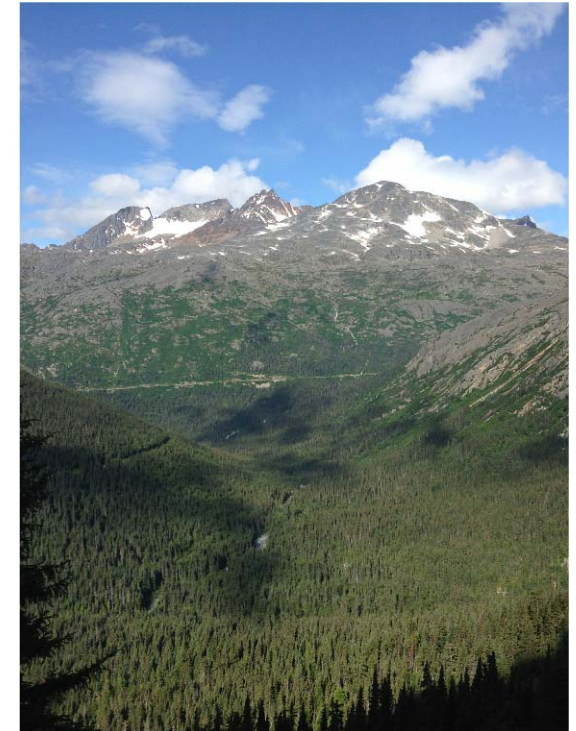

Monday, July 25

Juneau

This morning we will board our flight for an unforgettable journey to the great state of Alaska. Riley’s Motor Coach will be awaiting our arrival upon reaching our destination in Juneau, Alaska’s Capital City. We will then enjoy some of the sights of the city of Juneau including their biggest attraction, Mendenhall Glacier and the Macaulay Salmon Hatchery before going to our hotel, Baranof for our two night stay.

Tuesday, July 26

Juneau

Today is at your leisure. You may choose to relax at the hotel, shop, take a short jaunt to the Red Dog Saloon, ride up the Mount Roberts Tramway, tour the newly opened Alaska State Museum or truly have an Alaskan Experience by Salmon and Halibut fishing or Whale Watching that would be arranged prior to arrival.



Wednesday, July 27

Skagway

We will start our day with an early morning departure and cruise the Inside Passage to Skagway aboard the Alaska Ferry. This narrow passage will define the route early settlers traveled, passing glaciers and icebergs en route to Skagway, the town that owes its birth to the 1797 Gold Stampede. Skagway’s downtown historical district, false-fronted buildings, and boardwalk date back to the gold rush! We will take a short trip to the Gold Rush Cemetery and lower Reid Falls. Our overnight accommodations are at the Westmark of Skagway.

Thursday, July 28 Whitehorse, Canada

After breakfast we will board the Yukon/White Pass Railroad for an unbelievable breathtaking ride with photo opportunities around every turn. Our afternoon drive will include a picture stop at Carcross, Emerald Lake, and Miles Canyon and the SS Klondike, a sternwheeler boat, a national historic site located in Whitehorse. Tonight we will stay at the Westmark of Whitehorse.

Friday, July 29

Tok

This morning you will again be treated to breakfast and the remainder of the day will be spent traveling the Alaskan Highway. Originally built in 1949, the highway has been greatly improved the past several years. We will have an included lunch in Destruction Bay and a rest stop at Big Horn Sheep Mountain learning all about the wildlife of the area. Our home tonight will be in “The Crossroads of Alaska”– Tok.

Saturday, July 30

Fairbanks

We will start our day with breakfast at Fast Eddy’s and then continue our travels on the ALCAN Hwy. Just outside of Fairbanks we will stop in the town of North Pole for a chance to see the world famous Christmas House and the reindeer out back. Strike it rich - Guaranteed! Enjoy a close up view of the Trans Alaska Pipeline and a presentation

about its construction and operation. Then take a seat aboard a replica of the narrow-gauge Tanana Valley Railroad and hear the conductor tell tales of prospectors who arrived by the thousands during the gold rush. The train ride takes you to Gold Dredge 8 where you will see first-hand how the dredge worked the gold fields; then receive a brief but informative course on gold panning. Once the train arrives at the camp, you will try panning for yourself! You will find gold - we guarantee it! Tonight we’ll enjoy ourselves at the Salmon Bake feasting on all-you-can-eat salmon, cod, and prime rib. After dinner we’ll walk to Pioneer Park and enjoy “A True Alaska Experience”; a humorous musical depicting the “golden days” in Fairbanks. Our overnight stay will be in Fairbanks.

Sunday, July 31

Denali

This morning we will board the Discovery Riverboat and cruise the Tanana and Chena Rivers. We’ll explore the Eskimo cultures and see dog sled demonstrations as well as salmon fishing wheels. We will have an included meal after the riverboat returns.



We will travel to Denali National Park. Tonight we will have an unforgettable, true-to-life Gold Rush tale of adventure in the early 1900 Alaska. A night of food, frivolity, and good cheer awaits as the cast takes you through a lighthearted mix of colorful storytelling and spirited music. A hearty dinner complete with salmon, ribs, potatoes, old-fashioned baked beans, drop biscuits and berry cobbler, will surely satisfy your appetite!

Monday, August 1

Denali

Today we’ll board a park bus for a Natural History Tour of Denali National Park; keeping our eyes open for bear, moose, caribou, elk, birds and other small game.

While in Denali you may choose to do an optional activity such as a helicopter ride or river rafting.

Tuesday, August 2

Anchorage

After leaving Denali we’ll enjoy photo opportunities along the way, hoping to get a view of Denali - formerly Mt. McKinley.

After lunch we stop at the Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Museum - a log cabin with trophies, photos & videos of dog sledding, plus a gift shop & rides. We will continue our travels to Anchorage for an informal city tour, drive around Lake Hood and see the busiest airport in the world on water; pass Earthquake Park and many other interesting landmarks along the way. The evening is yours for shopping and dinner in downtown Anchorage.



Wednesday, August 3

Anchorage

As we drive to Whittier after breakfast, we will stop at the Alyeska Ski Resort for the Aerial Tramway: a seven-minute ride taking you to an observation deck which provides breath-taking panoramic views of majestic mountains, hanging glaciers, sparkling streams, towering spruce, and an array of wildlife. You will experience an unforgettable journey while traveling in comfort aboard the Klondike Express into Prince William Sound on a 26 Glacier Cruise. An informative narration by the US Forest Rangers is given through-out the excursion, as the serenity of Esther Passage and the majestic alpine and tidewater glaciers in College and Harriman Fjord come into view. A hot lunch is included while cruising.
