



Wednesday, July 6

This morning we will depart Sewing Seeds Quilt Co. of New Ulm en route to the airport and “stitch” our way to a quilting paradise. Our flight will arrive in Portland with plenty of time to smell the roses; where the City of Roses is always in full bloom. We will begin by taking a step back in time to the picturesque, and historic town of **McMinnville**. The town’s history can be dated back to the 1840’s. We’ll stitch our way through the beautiful historic center of McMinnville. It’s here where we will visit the family owned and operated since 1935, **Boersma’s Sewing Center**. Described by the town as the one stop shop for sewing enthusiasts, where everything is **SEW** much better you’ll find a variety of beautiful fabrics, patterns & kits to create your own works of art! The Boersma family purchased the Montgomery Ward building where their store is still located today in 1974. Previous to this ownership the building served as a Studebaker garage and then sat empty for several years. IF YOU LOOK CLOSELY, the Montgomery Ward logos can still be seen on the entrance door handles. We arrive in the scenic town of Newport, a quaint old fishing town nestled along the beautiful Yaquina Bay, for an opportunity for local shopping. As you make your way through this marine life filled town you can be entertained by the sea lions sunning themselves on the observations docks in town. We will end our day with the scenic Pacific Ocean views from our hotel stay at **The Elizabeth Ocean Front Suites in Newport**. Tonight choose to enjoy the breathtaking sunset from your balcony or while you walking the sandy beaches of the hotel.

Saturday, July 9 **SISTERS OUTDOOR QUILT SHOW™**

After breakfast we will spend the entire day at the Sisters Outdoor Quilt Show which literally “takes over the town” and the public has been educated and inspired about the art of quilting for over 40 years! Recognized as the most notable and largest outdoor Quilt Show in the world, this event draws an attendance of more than 12,000 visitors. Over 1,300 quilts are beautifully hanging outside every building; ranging

from traditional to contemporary to quirky - truly breathtaking works of art. You need not be a quilter or even a quilt lover, but you will be in awe of the multitude of beauty that is “all over the place”. A spare spot on a side wall or a square of land beckons yet another piece of creative artistry, and guaranteed - you will not be disappointed! After a fun-filled day we will return to our hotel for the evening.

Sunday, July 10

After breakfast we will continue our trail as we head back to Portland where we’ll immerse ourselves with the pungent fragrance of roses at the International

Rose Test Gardens; a relaxing ending to our quilting excursion. Our “**Stitchin’ a Trail to Oregon**” quilting experience comes to a close, taking with us “**kits of information**” and “**fabrics of friendship**”, while “**piecing**” together memories to last a lifetime.
