Day by Day Itinerary

Tuesday, March 30

South Bend, IN

This morning, we board our motor coach as we begin our travels through Wisconsin and northern Illinois. We'll stop for lunch and have rest breaks en route. We will be skirting around Chicago as we continue to our evening stay at the Embassy Suites in South Bend, Indiana.

Wednesday, March 31

Somerset, PA

Today we will be traveling east through the Great Lakes states of Indiana, Ohio and into Pennsylvania. Our lunch stop is en route before making an afternoon observation at the Flight 93 Memorial Site. Our accommodations for the evening are at the Comfort Inn at Somerset, Pennsylvania with an included dinner buffet at the Oakhurst Grill. **(B, D)**

Thursday, April 1

Lancaster, PA

This morning, sit back and enjoy the beautiful landscape of Pennsylvania with our tour destination being Gettysburg, which became the site of the turning point in the Civil War. The battlefields lay silent now, but memorials and visitors alike commemorate those who fought here. A step-on guide will join us as we relive the sights and sounds of these historical events. After spending a half-day in the Gettysburg area, we will board the motor coach for our short trip to the Country Inn of Lancaster, Pennsylvania for the next two nights. **(B)**

Friday, April 2

Lancaster, PA

A local guide joins us today as we tour the serene area where time has stood still for a hundred years. We'll see Amish farms where the horse and plow out-produce the tractor, and bearded Amish men work from dawn 'til dusk tilling and working the soil. We'll pause for a unique country lunch served family style at the Plain & Fancy Restaurant, and visit an Amish home furnished to reflect their unique lifestyle. Later this afternoon, you will be treated to a shopping stop at the Kitchen Kettle in Intercourse before returning to our hotel in Lancaster. **(B, L)**

Saturday, April 3

Alexandria, VA

Today, we will skirt around the city of Baltimore on our way into Washington D.C. Our first stop will be our Nation's Capitol. We will have lunch, followed by a guided tour.

Our next stop will be a tour of the Holocaust Memorial Museum. Our day in DC will be complete with a walk along side the Tidal Basin to view the Monuments and memorials hoping to see the blooming Cherry Blossom trees before driving to our hotel for a three-night stay at the Hampton Inn of Alexandria, located outside the metro area of Washington D.C. **(B)**

Sunday, April 4

Alexandria, VA

Before we begin touring, we will start our day with an optional church service at the National Cathedral. Next we will tour the National Museum of the Marine Corps, which opened its doors in 2006 as a lasting tribute to U.S. Marines – past, present, and future. We will be treated to an included lunch. We then travel to Mount Vernon where everyone can appreciate and enjoy America's historical and most famous presidential home of George and Martha Washington. We'll tour the mansion on the plantation and visit the museum. This evening, you will have the opportunity to ride the complimentary King Street Trolley and make your choice of one of the many eateries in Old Town Alexandria. **(B, L)**

Monday, April 5

Alexandria, VA

Our busy day will start with a tour of Arlington National Cemetery by trolley to visit the Kennedy Grave Sites, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier to witness the changing of the guard and the Arlington House. After lunch, a step-on guide will join us and explain the history behind the Vietnam, Air Force, World War II, Iwo Jima memorials, Washington Cathedral, and the Kennedy Center. One evening after dusk, you'll experience the awe-inspiring illumination of monuments and memorials in Washington D.C. **(B)**

Tuesday, April 6

LaVale, MD

Today, we will start our day with a photo stop of the White House, followed by a visit of the Ford Theater and the Peterson House and return to the Smithsonian Museum, giving you another opportunity to visit the galleries. This afternoon, Late afternoon, we'll bid farewell to Washington D.C. and the beauty of the Cherry Blossoms as we travel to northern Maryland through the beautiful Cumberland Mountain Range before reaching our destination in LaVale for our evening stay. **(B)**

Wednesday, April 7

Richmond, IN

After breakfast, enjoy the scenery while driving through Maryland, West Virginia, and Pennsylvania before arriving at our luncheon stop in Columbus, Ohio. Today, we'll travel to Dayton and visit the

United States Air Force Museum – one of the oldest and largest aviation museums in the world, featuring more than 300 aircrafts and missiles. Displays include early space suits and advanced missiles and bombs used during the Persian Gulf War. Our evening stay will be at the Home 2 of Richmond, Indiana. **(B)**

Thursday, April 8

New Glarus, WI

After driving through America's Heartland to Indiana, we will be amazed with the Fair Oaks Farms Adventure Center as their 35,000 cow dairy herd operation automatically milks 72 cows on a giant rotary parlor. Watch calves being born in the Birthing Barn and experience the massive swine operation from the birthing process to farrowing and finishing. Following the tour, you will have an included luncheon & ice cream at the farm before departing. Tonight, you will be treated to a Swiss Dinner & entertainment at the Chalet Landhaus Inn of New Glarus for our farewell dinner and overnight stay. **(B, L, D)**

Friday, April 9

Home

While traveling homeward, take time for reflections of the battlefields of Gettysburg, the Pennsylvania Dutch, all the sights surrounding our Nation's Capitol, and new friends we met along the way. The beauty and fragrance of the Cherry Blossoms will linger in our minds long after our journey ends.
