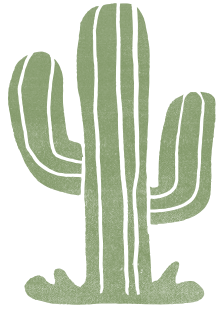

## Monday, February 15

Escape the Minnesota winter and arrive in Phoenix, beginning our adventure to a Winter Get-A-Way! The sunny Southwest extends a warm invitation for visitors to explore regions and cities known for perfect weather and magnificent scenery. There is much to experience, discover

and enjoy, as our motor coach awaits our arrival and we'll make our way to our overnight accommodations at the Cameron Trading Post. Sunset views, the people, and the culture are unlike anywhere else to experience the Southwest.



## Tuesday, February 16

Our day includes the breath-taking scenery of the Grand Canyon. A step-on guide will join our motor coach, and stop at multiple over-looks of the majestic Grand Canyon with the Colorado River running below. We will have an included lunch at the Trading Post known for their Navajo Taco. This afternoon, we will travel to the picturesque community of Sedona for a two-night stay at the Best Western Plus Arroyo Roble Hotel, located in the heart of Uptown Sedona offering stunning views of Oak Creek and the surrounding mountains.

## Wednesday, February 17

Today, experience the south side of Sedona, via the Sedona Trolley. The one-hour trolley will meander through Uptown and Sedona's Arts District, passing by many impressive scenic red rock formations, and to the TOP of Chapel Of The Holy Cross hill. The remainder of the day is yours to explore, experience, and fall in love with Sedona.

## Thursday, February 18

Photos opportunities arise for your collection of memories as we enjoy an afternoon of sightseeing while traveling through the lush Verde Valley. "All Aboard" the Verde Canyon Railroad where asphalt and concrete drift away, slipping into an unspoiled world where serenity and stimulation miraculously coincide. As you board the train you will bring your included box lunch on board, the four-hour narrated wilderness adventure running from Clarkdale to Perkinsville at 12 mph makes for a stress free and relaxing excursion. The train will pass vintage trestles, travel through a 734-foot tunnel and tour beautiful red rock canyon scenery and the riparian curves of the Verde River. After our train excursion, we will travel by motor coach through the Oak Creek Canyon, surpassed only by the Grand Canyon for scenic beauty, to our accommodations for the next five nights at the comfortable Country Inn & Suites of Mesa.

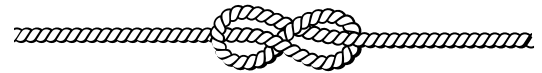
## Friday, February 19

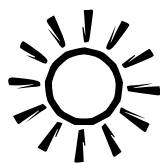
