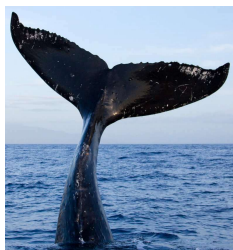

After lunch, we will stop at the Alyeska Ski Resort for the Aerial Tramway, a seven minute ride taking you to an observation deck which provides breathtaking panoramic views of majestic mountains, hanging glaciers, sparkling streams, towering spruce, and an array of wildlife. We will continue on to explore downtown Anchorage, before going to our hotel for a twonight stay.

Sunday, June 28**Anchorage**

Today, experience an unforgettable journey while traveling in comfort aboard a highspeed catamaran into Prince William Sound on a Glacier Quest Cruise, with an informative narration by the US Forest Rangers and an included lunch.

**Monday, June 29****Denali**

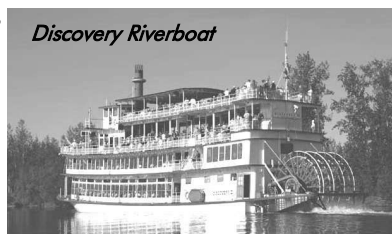
We'll visit the Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Museum where a video lets us experience "The Last Great Race on Earth". View trophies, displays, photos, and for a fee, take a thrilling trip down the trail with the dogs that make the Iditarod so unique. We will have lunch enroute. When traveling to Denali, we'll enjoy photo opportunities along the way, hoping to get a view of Denali formerly Mt. McKinley. A night of food, frivolity, and good cheer awaits as the cast takes you through an unforgettable, truetolife Gold Rush tale of adventure in the early 1900 Alaska. The lighthearted mix of colorful storytelling, spirited music, and a hearty dinner complete with salmon, ribs, potatoes, oldfashioned baked beans, drop biscuits and berry cobbler, will surely satisfy your appetite! Our accommodations will be in the village of Denali for twonights.

Tuesday, June 30**Denali**

After breakfast, we'll board a park bus for a Natural History Tour of Denali National Park, keeping our eyes open for bear, moose, caribou, elk, birds and other small wildlife. While in Denali, you may choose to do an optional activity such as a helicopter ride or river rafting.

*Denali***Wednesday, July 1****Fairbanks**

A relaxing start of the day will begin with breakfast before making our way to Fairbanks. This afternoon, join the Binkley family as we board the Discovery Riverboat and cruise the Tanana and Chena Rivers. We'll explore the Eskimo cultures and see dog sled demonstrations as well as salmon fishing wheels. Tonight, we'll enjoy ourselves at the Salmon Bake, feasting on salmon, cod, and prime rib. After dinner, walk to Pioneer Park and enjoy "A True Alaska Experience"; a humorous musical depicting the "golden days" in Fairbanks.

*Discovery Riverboat***Thursday, July 2****Tok**

Strike it rich Guaranteed! Experience Alaska's gold mining history at Gold Dredge 8. Enjoy a close up view of the Trans Alaska Pipeline and a presentation about its construction and operation. Take a seat aboard a replica of the narrowgauge Tanana Valley Railroad and hear the conductor tell tales of prospectors who arrived by the thousands during the gold rush. The train takes you to Gold Dredge 8 where you will see firsthand how the dredge worked the gold fields; then receive a brief but informative course on gold panning. Once the train arrives at the camp, you will try panning for yourself! You will find gold we guarantee it!! Just outside of Fairbanks we will stop in the town of North Pole for a chance to see the world famous Christmas House and the reindeer out back. Our home tonight will be in "The Crossroads of Alaska"—Tok.

Friday, July 3**Whitehorse, Yukon**

This morning, you will again be treated to breakfast and the remainder of the day will be spent traveling the Alaskan Highway. Originally built in 1949, the highway has been greatly improved in recent years. Enjoy an included lunch in Destruction Bay. A rest stop at Big Horn Sheep Mountain will

familiarize you with the wildlife of the area. As we enter Whitehorse, we will have a photo stop at the S.S. Klondike, the largest stern wheeler to forge the mighty Yukon River. Afterwards we will check into our accommodations and the rest of the evening is on our own to relax and enjoy.

Saturday, July 4**Skagway**

As we leave the city of Whitehorse, we will see the largest weather vane in the world, and a spectacular view is in store from the Miles Canyon Lookout on the Alaska Highway. We will travel along the Chilkoot Pass and the White Pass before arriving in Fraser. We will board the White Pass/ Yukon Route Railroad for an excursion with photo opportunities around every turn. The train will arrive in Skagway, the town that owes its birth to the 1797 Gold Stampede, with their downtown historical district, false fronted buildings, and boardwalk dating back to the Gold Rush! Our overnight accommodations are at the Westmark of Skagway.

**ALL ABOARD!****White Pass & Yukon Route****Sunday, July 5****Juneau**

The morning is at your leisure to experience Skagway, with an afternoon departure and cruise of the Inside Passage aboard the Alaska Ferry. This narrow passage will define the route early settlers traveled, passing glaciers and icebergs en route to Juneau, Alaska's Capital City, for our twonight stay.

Monday, July 6**Juneau**

Enjoy the city of Juneau including their biggest attraction, Mendenhall Glacier. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. You may choose to relax at the hotel, shop for last minute souvenirs, take a short jaunt to the Red Dog Saloon, ride up the Mount Roberts Tramway, visit the Alaska State Museum or ask your escort to arrange a whale watching or fishing excursion for you!
