Wednesday, July 24

Bismark, ND

Our Canadian Rockies adventure begins by traveling with deluxe motor coach through central Minnesota to our included buffet lunch in Fargo. After lunch, we will make our way to Bismark for our overnight accommodations at the Fairfield Inn & Suites.

Thursday, July 25

Medora, ND

We will start our day off with a visit to the "Skyscraper on the Prairie", the North Dakota State Capital, for a guided tour. We will also tour the State History Museum. This evening, you will take part in a unique Medora treat, The Pitchfork Fondue, that will have you saying "the best steak ever!" After dinner, you will enjoy the Medora Musical production. This outdoor splendor takes place in a 2,900 seat amphitheater, and history comes alive nightly with western themes and top-notch variety acts. Tonight, we will be staying at the Badlands Motel in Medora.



Friday, July 26

Shelby, MT

Today, our travels will take us across the state of Montana. We will have an included lunch in the small town of Fort Peck before arriving in Shelby, MT, which is located on the East side of Glacier National Park.

Saturday, July 27

Fernie, BC



This morning, we'll travel to East Glacier where the historic Red Coaches are waiting for our guided tour of the "Going-to-the-Sun-Road". We will cross the Continental Divide at Logan Pass while enjoying the breathtaking view along this magnificent road.

Our afternoon travels take us north into Canada, with an overnight stay at the Park Place Lodge in Fernie, British Columbia, Canada.

Sunday, July 28

After breakfast, we can enjoy the beautiful valleys of B.C. with a stop in Radium Hot Springs for our morning break. We will continue onward Golden, BC and have a relaxing included lunch at the Island Restaurant before entering Yoho National Park. The park is located along the western slopes of the Canadian Rockies. We will climb the Kicking Horse River Valley toward the continental divide into Alberta. This afternoon, embrace the awe-inspiring scenery that Lake Louise offers, taking advantage of the opportunity to walk by the lake while enjoying the view. Our day concludes with a cruise on Lake Minnewanka to take in the beautiful valley landscape of Canada's oldest National Park. Our home for the next two nights is at the Rundlestone Lodge in Banff. Nestled high in the Canadian Rockies, Banff is a town that makes you feel at home and exhilarated with wonder all at the same time.



Monday, July 29

After breakfast, our motor coach will wind through the Canadian Rockies, traveling on one of the most picturesque highways. From there, our group will board the Snocoach on the Athabasca Glacier where you will be standing on one of the largest accumulations of ice south of the Arctic Circle. Time is allowed for lunch and shopping in the quaint little town of Jasper. After lunch, we will view one of the beautiful water falls in the Jasper area, the Athabasca Falls. We will have an included dinner at Saskatchewan Crossing before returning to our hotel.

Tuesday, July 30

This morning, heighten your senses and experience the all-new Banff Gondola Summit. Journey to the top of Sulphur Mountain for the 360-degree rooftop observation deck, multi-sensory theater, and more. Before lunch, we will have additional time to explore downtown Banff.
