
General Information:

Tour Price: **\$1,845 per person** based on two people sharing a double room. Single-\$2,110, Triple-\$1,770, and Quad-\$1,730.

Thursday, April 11

Quilting experience at the **32nd** Lancaster Quilt Show. It is the longest running quilt show in Lancaster with over 45 vendors and 150 quilts on display. After a full day at the quilt show, we will return to our hotel. Tonight, we will have a true Amish experience. Along with a guide, we will tour the Amish Farmland and enjoy a traditional Amish familystyle meal, served in an Amish home, by an host family.

Fridøy, April 12

Today will feature the Log Cabin Quilt Shop and Fabrics. You can browse the extensive inventory of fabrics, charm packs, jelly rolls, patterns, pillows and Amish souvenirs. Our morning will continue as we stroll through the

community. The local artisans will showcase their exceptional handcrafted merchandise in a setting that is as unique as the goods themselves.



This afternoon, we will visit **The Quilt Shop at Miller's**, featuring handmade quilts, quillows, wall hangings and gift items from Amish, Mennonite and local artisans. This 3,500 squarefoot showroom allows you to explore over 600 hand-stitched quilts.



This evening, you will enjoy the production of **Daniel at the Sight & Sound** Theater. From the fiery furnace to the infamous dens of lions, Daniel is a spectacular theatrical experience. Witness one of the Bible's most hope-filled stories as it come to life.

Saturday, April 13

Our true **Amish Experience** begins with a five screen theater production of "Jacob's Choice". A local guide joins us today as we tour the serene area where



time has stood still for a hundred years. We'll see Amish farms where the horse and plow out-produce the tractor, and bearded Amish men work from dawn 'til dusk tilling and working the soil. We will tour an Amish home & school house furnished to reflect their unique lifestyle. We'll pause for a unique country lunch, a grand smorgasbord with an ever-changing selection of home-cooked, farm-fresh dishes and desserts. Later this afternoon, you will be treated to a shopping stop at the **Kitchen Kettle Village** & **The Old Country Quilt Store** in Intercourse before returning to our hotel in Lancaster.
