# Wednesday, July 10 Philadelphia, PA

Our morning drive takes us to the birthplace of our Nation – Philadelphia! From the signing of the Declaration of Independence to the ringing of the Liberty Bell to the

first presidential executive mansion, the city known as the "Cradle of Liberty" has something for every history buff. A step-on guide will share their knowledge of America's most historic square mile. Recognizable for its crack, the Liberty Bell is an

iconic symbol of American Independence. We'll visit Independence Hall where both the United States Declaration of Independence and the United States Constitution were debated and adopted. Breathe in the cultures and times at the Philadelphia Museum of Art, climb the famous steps for a photo opportunity, and enjoy posing with the bigger-than-life boxer, Rocky Balboa, cast in bronze. Overnight accommodations are at the Wyndham, located in the heart of Old City Philadelphia. Enjoy night life, shopping, dining and sample the famous "Philly Cheesesteak" at the nearby restaurants.

# Thursday, July 11 Virginia Beach, VA

Are you one of many who have never traveled to Delaware? This morning, your dream will come true as we drive south to Dover, the state capital of Delaware. We'll have a guided tour of the Delaware Legislative Hall, which houses the chambers and offices of the Delaware General Assembly. A behind the scenes tour at the Delaware Public Archives gives us insight to the official repository of historical public records dating from 1653 to the current year. After lunch, we'll drive via the Chesapeake Bay Bridge – Tunnel, a 23-mile fixed link connecting Northampton County with Virginia Beach. You'll smell the

salt in the air this evening as our accommodations are oceanfront at the Hampton Inn, Virginia Beach.

Friday, July 12 Williambsurg, VA

The Cape Henry Lighthouse is our first stop today. The location has been an important factor with a large amount of ocean-going shipping traffic for the harbors, its rivers, and for shipping headed to ports on the bay. Group adventure awaits us as we

travel to Norfolk, VA, where we'll embark Battleship Wisconsin – one of the largest and last battleships built by the U.S. Navy. Walk the main deck during our guided tour and experience hands on exhibits, a 3D theater, shark tanks, aquariums, and imagine what it was like living on board as a sailor. This afternoon trace the footsteps of Captain John Smith and Pocahontas when we visit two of the Historic Triangle colonies. Visitors are immersed in the world of America's first permanent English colony when our guide meets us at Jamestown Settlement. Climb aboard re-creations of the three ships that sailed from England to Virginia in 1607, and explore life-size re-creations of the colonists' fort and a Powhatan village. In the outdoor areas, costumed historical interpreters describe and demonstrate daily life in early 17th century Jamestown. Colonial Williamsburg's Revolutionary City will become your home away from home at our second colony of the Historic Triangle for the next two nights at the Woodlands Hotel & Suites. Tonight eat, drink, and be merry at a Colonial Tavern while enjoying an included dinner.

#### Saturday, July 13 Williamsburg

Your guide today will make you feel like you've become a citizen as you explore and engage with the community and experience firsthand the triumphs and struggles of people from all walks of life. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to take advantage of the complimentary

shuttle service from the hotel to the historical downtown for shopping, relaxation or enjoying night-life in Williamsburg.



#### Sunday, July 14 Lexington, VA

This morning, we will travel west and enjoy an included lunch at Southern Kitchen. After lunch, we will have a one-hour guided tour of the Shenandoah Caverns. Visitors have been thrilled for over 90 years while exploring an underground world of natural wonders, geology and crystalline formations. It is the ONLY Virginia cavern with elevator service, making it one of the easiest to tour. Surrounded by the breathtaking beauty of the Shenandoah Valley, new discoveries come before us as we drive through the Shenandoah National Park; continuing on our drive to Lexington; a

college town rich with history, charm and natural wonders. The Hampton Inn, located in the Historic District of Lexington, Virginia welcomes us to the accommodations for our overnight stay.
