Tuesday, February 18

Wednesday, February 19

Prepare for a full day guided tour when we visit Tombstone, "The Town too Tough to Die"! We'll visit Bird Cage Museum, filled with wonderful artifacts, including the "Black Moriah" – the hearse that hauled the town's dead to Boot Hill. Listed in the Guinness Book of World Records is the "Shady Lady", the world's largest rose bush. She stands tall and stretches wide in the back garden of the Tombstone Rose Tree Museum. The museum also features a fascinating collection of historic artifacts of the town's yesteryear. You'll experience an enjoyable included lunch at Big Nose Kate's Saloon, the historic watering hole in Tombstone, and the best Cowboy bar in the west. After lunch, we'll take a short drive to the famous copper mining town of Bisbee. "The cowboys live in Tombstone and the hippies live in Bisbee, 23 miles apart and 100 years away from each other".

Thursday, February 20

See all that the historic Old Pueblo has to offer when we travel to Tucson and visit sights along the way on a full day city tour of Tucson. Your guide will share a wealth of information about the city, including the San Xavier Mission, Barrios, and historic downtown area. You will have time for lunch on your own and shopping. Our afternoon consists of travels to the Mesa/Phoenix area.



Mesa is the largest suburban city by population in the United States. We'll check into our hotel accommodations for the next five nights at the comfortable Country Inn & Suites of Mesa. Good food, comfortable atmosphere, and the world's largest Wurlitzer Theatre Pipe Organ offer a unique dining experience this evening at Organ Stop Pizza. Enjoy a short organ recital while you dine and we'll return to our hotel to relax for the evening.

Friday, February 21

Adventures for today include Tortilla Flats, the tiny town with only one main street. Lunch is on your own, and while your there don't forget to sample the "killer chili". It might be wise to have a beverage handy after tasting! 
General Information:
