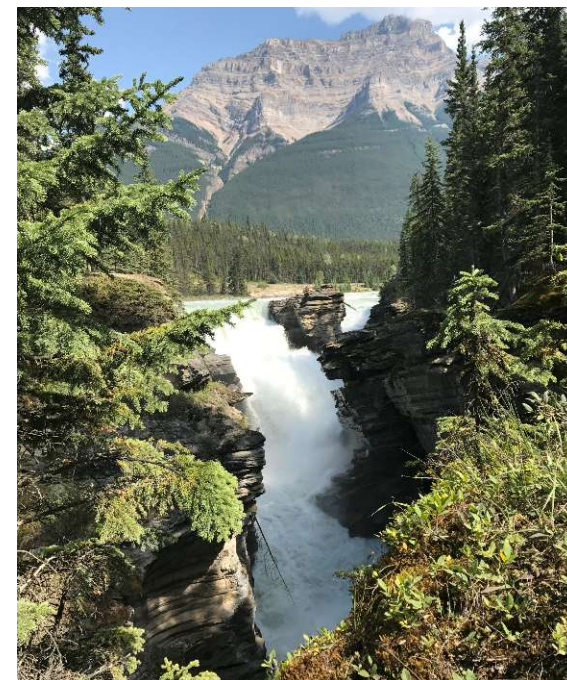

Monday, June 29

Winnipeg, MB

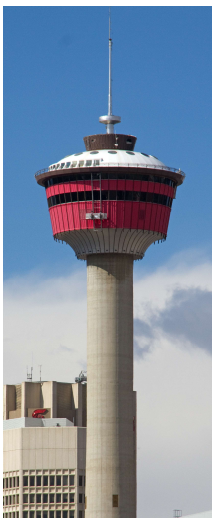

Sunday, July 5

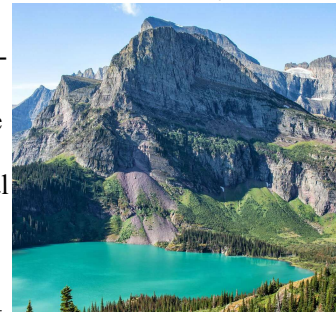
Kalispell, MT
