April 2027 - Join us on a spectacular 11-day, 8-night vacation visiting Melbourne, Victoria's elegant capital city; Cairns, the gateway to the Great Barrier Reef; and picturesque Sydney. Afterward, for those interested, we'll continue on an *optional* 7-night extension to New Zealand spending 5-nights on the North Island and 2-nights on the South Island.



MELBOURNE - Victoria's elegant capital is one of the world's most varied cities, with a quality of lifestyle envied by many, with the Yarra River at the heart of the city's charm. A highlight of our visit to Melbourne will include a tour to Phillip Island for a unique wildlife experience. We'll stop in the seaside town of Cowes to view Australia's largest seal population, visit the Koala Conservation Centre where we can walk among the treetops to observe the cuddly koalas, and travel to Western Port to witness the "penguin" parade.



CAIRNS - The northern gateway to the Great Barrier Reef where the weather is always warm, the water clear and the locals friendly. One of many highlights on tour will include a cruise to the uninhabited Frankland Islands on Cairns Great Barrier Reef. You can choose to stay dry and discover this underwater paradise with a coral viewing tour from the semi-submersible or glass bottom boat or jump right in and explore the swimming and snorkeling areas.

SYDNEY - Sydney, capital of New South Wales, is best known for its Harbour Front Sydney Opera House, with a distinctive sail-like design. We'll enjoy a private visit to the famous Taronga Zoo for a "Daybreak Breakfast" travel by ferry for a walking tour of the "Rocks" to hear the details of the country's fascinating history and take to the waters an invigorating Captain Cook afternoon coffee cruise.

NEW ZEALAND - The *optional extension* will introduce us to the best of both the North and South Islands. We'll begin with a visit to Auckland, sprawling across an isthmus between the Tasman Sea and the Pacific Ocean and noted for its extensive parks and beautiful gardens. Then, we travel to Rotorua, the oldest and perhaps best-known resort in the country that has for over 150,000 years been rumbling with subterranean energy. Our visit to the North Island ends with an overnight in Wellington, the cosmopolitan capital city situated at the southern end of the Island and located on the shore of a magnificent harbor where the winds off Cook Strait can always be felt. Next up, the South Island awaits where we'll our last 2-nights in Queenstown, an alpine town located on Lake Wakatipu and surrounded by mountains. Featured will be a full length cruise of picturesque Milford Sound.
