Day by Day Itinerary

Mon., Apr. 6 – MINNEAPOLIS / EN ROUTE

We depart Minneapolis this afternoon by scheduled airline service to begin the transatlantic overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal. (I)

Tues., Apr. 7 – LISBON / Nazare / PORTO

As the sun begins to rise on the Portuguese coast we arrive in Lisbon where we'll meet our local transfer representative for the journey north to Porto. Along the way, we'll stop in the seaside town of Nazare where an atmosphere of times gone by make it a special place to visit. After lunch, we then set our sights on the historic city of Oporto. Known locally as Porto, the city's ideal geographical location at the mouth of the Douro River has led to a unique architectural heritage of exceptional quality. On arrival in Porto we'll board CroisiEurope's MS Miguel Torga. In no time at all, we'll be settled into our luxurious accommodations and have an opportunity to familiarize ourselves with all the first-class aspects of our floating boutique hotel. (I,L,D)

Wed., Apr. 8 – PORTO / CRUISING

Our introduction to Porto will begin in the Cathedral District where we'll see the soaring Torre dos Clerigos tower and stop to visit Sao Bento Station, with its alluring azulejos illustrating modes of transportation. Next, we'll see the Mannerist Igreja de Santa Clara, the massive granite Se Cathedral, and Gothic Sao Francisco church before stopping to visit the Palacio da Bolsa, where the city's merchants built the stock exchange and its contemporary Arabian Hall inspired by Granada's Alhambra. Afterward, we'll have an opportunity to explore Ribeira, the riverside quarter lined with cafes and outdoor markets. Then we'll cross the Douro River and travel to Vila Nova de Gaia to visit the famous Caves Croft wine cellar where port wine is produced from grapes of the Douro Valley. The quay is dotted with outdoor cafes selling various vintages of port wine, a perfect way to start our day.


Ahead lies our Douro River cruise aboard the MS Miguel Torga ~ get set to explore what is possibly Europe's most undiscovered river valley dotted with charming villages, age-old traditions, and wonderful wines. This afternoon we sail along the Douro River, at one time a wild river, notoriously challenging to navigate. Today it has been tamed by a system of dams and locks, which have raised the water level. The river here is at its most gentle, as we sail into rural territory towards the Spanish border. (B,L,D)

Thurs., Apr. 9 - CRUISING (Peso da Régua)

One of the benefits of life aboard a river cruise is the sheer sense of relaxation it brings. Enjoy the morning at leisure while simply watching the riverbank scenery passing by from the comfort of a cozy seat in the lounge. This morning we arrive in Peso da Régua where we'll visit the **Douro Museum** to learn about the winemaking heritage in the region. Afterward, we'll travel by motorcoach to Vila Real to visit the grounds of splendid **Mateus Palace**. Built in the first half of the 18th century, the palace is set among beautiful gardens on a vast farm, considered one of the finest examples of baroque civil architecture in Portugal. Following our visit, we'll continue by motorcoach to the small town of Pinhão to rejoin the *MS Miguel Torga*. **(B,L,D)**

Fri., Apr. 10 - CRUISING (Salamanca)

Today's port of call is the peaceful town of Vega de Terron, Spain. From here, we travel by motorcoach to Salamanca, regarded by many Spaniards as their nation's most beautiful city. As we'll soon find out, Salamanca is exceptionally alluring and boasts two magnificent cathedrals standing on a single site. We'll visit both the **New Cathedral** built in the Gothic style and the **Old Cathedral** offering visitors the chance to admire a truly magnificent Romanesque monument. We'll also explore the **University of Salamanca grounds**. Founded in 1218, the university is the oldest



in Spain and was one of the civilized world's most important seats of study for over 400 years. Afterward, free time will be set aside to explore the **Plaza Mayor**. Possibly Spain's finest public square, it was built in the 18th century with colonnaded walkways. Following our time in Salamanca we'll rejoin our ship in the sleepy Portuguese village of Barca d'Alva. **(B,L,D)**

Sat., Apr. 11 – CRUISING (Port Wine Route)

We will enjoy a day cruising, or for those interested, join us as we get set to explore Portugal's **Port Wine Route**. The route winds through gorgeous scenery on our way to the small town of Pinhão where we'll take part in a **Quinta Wine Tasting** to learn about all the stages of wine production; from the planting of the vines, to harvesting, the wine-making process and finally tasting and labeling. We'll also stop to visit the **Pinhão Railway Station**, considered one of the most beautiful stations along the Douro River. Built during the 19th century, the station's façades are decorated with 25 azulejo tile panels, which portray work in the vineyards and local landscapes. **(B,L,D)**

Sun., Apr. 12 – PORTO / CASCAIS

This morning we disembark from CroisiEurope's MS Miguel Torga and set our sights on Alcobaca where we'll tour Portugal's largest church, the Mosteiro de Santa Maria de Alcobaça. Founded in 1553 by the first Portuguese king, the Cistercian monastery was one of the most prestigious in medieval Europe. We'll also have time to explore the covered market. Known for showcasing local produce and culinary traditions the market is said to sell the best fruit in Portugal, as well as porcelain and crystal glassware. Then we'll be on our way to the Estremadura region where we'll stop to explore the enchanting hill town of Obidos, whose pretty whitewashed houses are enclosed within 14th century walls. The entrance to town will take us through the Porta da Vila and then a walk along the Rua Direita, the main shopping street, to the Praca de Santa Maria where we'll have an opportunity to enjoy a Ginjinha Tasting, the traditional Portuguese cherry liqueur. Our day comes to an end upon arrival in the charming beachside town of Cascais, located on the Portuguese Riviera, known for its lovely beaches, historic architecture, and vibrant culture, offering a blend of natural beauty and urban sophistication. (B,D)

Mon., Apr. 13 – CASCAIS (Lisbon)

Today we travel into the capital city of Lisbon. Built on seven hills, the attraction of the Portuguese capital lies in the deep shade of its many tree-lined streets and squares, and the magnificent vistas along its wide avenues. An introductory tour of Lisbon will take us along the banks of the Tagus River where we'll stop to view both the Monument to the Discoveries, built to mark the 500th anniversary of the death of Henry the Navigator, and the Torre de Belem. Afterward, we'll travel along the grand Avenida Liberdade, the broad tree-lined avenue that is Lisbon's fashionable main thoroughfare, before finishing in the Alfama District. Here we'll peer into Lisbon's Moorish past as we explore a colorful maze of winding cobblestone streets little changed since the 12th century. (B)

Tues., Apr. 14 - CASCAIS / MINNEAPOLIS

This morning we travel to Humberto Delgado Airport in preparation for our return journey home. No better time to reflect on memories of our *Douro River Cruise* vacation to last a lifetime and new friendships made along the way! **(B,I)**
