### Monday, Sept. 7

### Harris, MI

This morning, we will depart Minnesota crossing the Mississippi River on our way through central Wisconsin. Our evening stay is at the Island Resort & Casino in Harris, Michigan. This exciting “playground” for adults offers food venues, slots, blackjack, craps, poker & more for those who want to try their luck!



### Tuesday, Sept. 8 Mackinac Island, MI

We'll begin the morning with breakfast at our hotel. Our route today will be on Michigan scenic Hwy #2 as we skirt the shores of Lake Michigan. We will cross the massive Mackinac Bridge and arrive in Mackinaw City to board the ferry to the Island. A horse-drawn carriage will be awaiting your arrival to take us to the luxurious Grand Hotel. We'll have time to enjoy spectacular views of the Straits of Mackinac and the beautiful gardens while standing on the world's longest porch. We'll be guests for an included lunch buffet at the Grand Hotel, which has welcomed visitors since 1887. In the afternoon we will be transported by horse carriage to the Murray Hotel, a quaint, family-owned hotel located on the island in the heart of downtown, where we will be staying the next two nights. The remainder of the day will be at your leisure to rent a bicycle built for two and explore the island, go for a walk, take time for shopping, sample the ice cream and taffy and enjoy dinner on your own at one of the many fine restaurants. ### Wednesday, Sept. 9 Mackinac Island, MI

Experience the History and Charm of Mackinac on a narrated carriage tour of the island. Prepare yourself for a tour like no other! What you will experience is by far the most enjoyable and authentic way to view the island. The tour will include Traditional Carriage Tour, Surry Hills Museum, Arch Rock, which stands on Lake Huron Shoreline 146 feet above the water, and admission to Fort Mackinac, where living history is preserved in this American Revolutionary Era fort. The remainder of the afternoon and evening is on your own to enjoy island life. (B)

### Thursday, Sept. 10

### Green Bay, WI

After breakfast, we will depart the island by ferry taking us to Mackinaw City, and board the motorcoach. Have your cameras ready as once again we'll cross the Mackinac Bridge and begin our scenic afternoon drive through the beautiful countryside of Wisconsin. Late this afternoon, we will be entering the Green Bay area for a tour of Lambeau Field and visit the Green Bay Packers Hall of Fame Museum. Our home for the next two evenings will be at the Oneida Casino Hotel. (B)

### Green Bay, WI

After breakfast, we will begin a full-day tour of Door County, including the Maritime Museum and Door Peninsula Winery.
