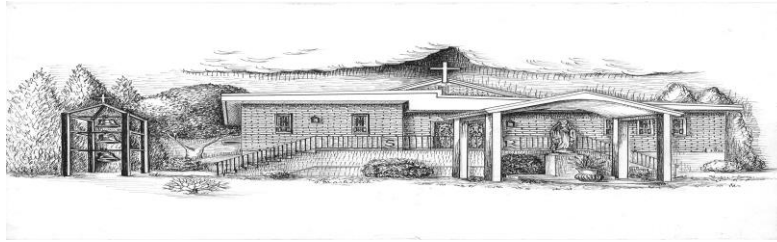

### 2022 MASS INTENTION BOOK:

Intentions accepted using the Mass Intention Form and be mailed, placed in any collection or dropped at the rectory. The Mass stipend is \$10 per Mass. Any issues with your request, the office will contact with you.

Currently there are no restrictions, however; to try and accommodate the intentions (which also includes reserved dates), please consider having a weekday Mass or remembering your loved one through the Purgatorial Society, Sanctuary Lamp or one of the devotional candles.

#### Sponsor Eligibility:

Certificates of Eligibility for Baptism and Confirmation require the sponsor to be a registered & active member of the parish, and if married, in a valid marriage recognized by the Catholic Church. Please call the parish office for additional information.

#### Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptisms are usually celebrated on a Sunday afternoon. Parents need to be registered parishioners and attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. At least one Godparent must be a practicing Catholic and also obtain a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish.

#### Sacrament of Marriage:

Arrangements should be made at least 6 months prior to the proposed wedding date to begin pre-nuptial instructions before making any arrangements. Please call the parish office for more information and schedule an appointment with the Pastor.
