Updated Covid Guidelines: (Delta Variant) effective immediately

The Pennsylvania Bishops convened this morning regarding the rise of the Delta Variant and the upcoming August 15th reinstitution of the Sunday Mass Obligation across the Commonwealth.

The Bishops have decided that no change in date will take place. August 15th will remain the date for the General Dispensation to cease statewide. As always, those homebound, infirmed, or with a serious anxiety about gathering in public settings are dispensed.

After discussion among the Bishops, His Excellency, Most Reverend Alfred A. Schlert has reimposed the following Guidelines, effective immediately:

- Masks are to be worn during the Distribution of Holy Communion by all Priests, Deacons, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, regardless of vaccination status.
- Masks are to be worn by ushers when greeting the faithful at the doors of the Church and while taking up the collection, regardless of vaccination status.
- Sanitizing stations are to be utilized by the Ministers of Holy Communion.
- The Exchange of the Sign of Peace and the Distribution of the Precious Blood remain suspended.

1. No one is required to wear a facemask on diocesan property. Those who wish to continue to wear one are free to do so as well.

2. NO CAPACITY LIMITATIONS will be required in parishes and institutions within the geographical territory of the Diocese of Allentown.

3. Weekday Mass and Sunday Mass attendees may enter and exit the church using <u>both</u> the ramp and front doors 30 minutes before the scheduled Mass.

4. The Distribution of Holy Communion is to return to the proper place in the liturgy in the Church only. It is no longer permitted to distribute after Mass.

5. Holy Water: All fonts and stoops will return to being filled.

6. Votive Candles: Parishioners may now light votive candles. Please hand sanitize before and after lighting the candles.

7. Altar servers, Lectors, and Extraordinary Eucharistic Ministers are permitted.

8. The Exchange of the Sign of Peace is not permitted.
