#### THE BOILER HAS GIVEN UP THE GHOST

The 1960s era boiler that heats the school building, which includes the Parish Hall, all the classrooms, the kitchen, and even the front sacristy in the church has died. There is currently no heat or hot water in any of these areas. Bids are currently being secured for repair or replacement, and it is seeming that it will be the latter given the age of this boiler. We are also looking into a temporary electric replacement to prevent any of the water or heating pipes from freezing and causing additional expense. Until further notice, there will no in-person Youth Formation in the classrooms and no coffee hour after Mass.
