## 2023 MASS INTENTION BOOK: PLEASE READ

The Mass Book is now open. Intentions will be accepted through the 2023 Revised Mass Intention Form (found in church or online) and can be mailed, placed in the collection, or dropped at the office. Please use this revised form since it is different from previous years. The form(s) must also be fully completed with the \$10 per Mass stipend enclosed.

As there is an overflow of Masses and Mass times are limited; we cannot guarantee a specific date and time for Mass intentions. To try and accommodate the intentions (which also includes reserved dates), there is a <u>limit of three Masses per family</u>. Please also consider having a weekday Mass or remembering your loved one through the Eternal Remembrance Society, the Sanctuary Lamp or one of the Devotional Candles.

If there is a question with your request, the office will contact you.

### Sponsor Eligibility:

Certificates of Eligibility for Baptism and Confirmation require the sponsor to be a registered & active member of the parish, and if married, in a valid marriage recognized by the Catholic Church. Please call the parish office for additional information.

### Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptisms are usually celebrated on a Sunday afternoon. Parents need to be registered parishioners and attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. At least one Godparent must be a practicing Catholic and also obtain a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish.

## Sacrament of Marriage:

Arrangements should be made at least 6 months prior to the proposed wedding date to begin pre-nuptial instructions before making any arrangements. Please call the parish office for more information and schedule an appointment with the Pastor.
