**Diocesan Men's Conference:** Registration is currently open for the 2018 Diocesan Men's Conference, "Spiritual Combat: Armed with the Spirit," Saturday, November 3rd at DeSales University, Center Valley. The conference will focus on spiritual warfare. Presenters will explore how men can grow closer to God in the midst of daily struggle and temptation, and the importance of spiritual surrender. This 7<sup>th</sup> men's conference will include keynote speakers and opportunities for Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament, the Sacrament of Reconciliation and a Saturday evening Vigil Mass celebrated by Bishop of Allentown Alfred Schlert. **New Saints:** This Sunday, October 14th, Pope Francis will canonize two new saints: Archbishop Oscar Romero and Pope Paul VI. Archbishop Romero was martyred by the Salvadoran military in 1980 while celebrating Mass. His defense of the poor and oppressed people of El Salvador and his outspoken criticism of their government sanctioned oppressor, led to his being put on a "death list". St. Oscar is celebrated as a special patron of the least of our brothers and sisters.

Pope Paul VI guided the Church through the reforms of the Second Vatican Council, was the first pope to travel to the United Nations, was the first pope to meet the Orthodox Patriarch in 1000 years, and authored Humanae Vitae, the controversial encyclical that prophetically pointed out the dangers of separating sexual activity from its divine purpose of procreation. St. Paul VI is celebrated as a patron of those who evangelize and those who work to protect the sanctity of human life. (EWTN will likely have reruns of the canonization on Sunday.)
